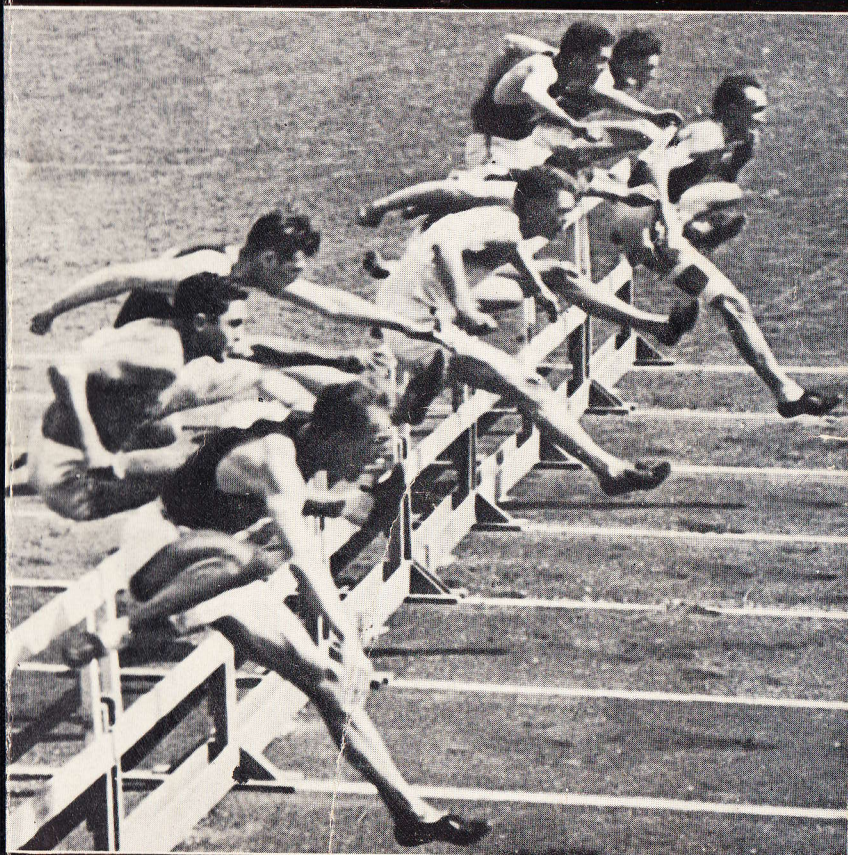

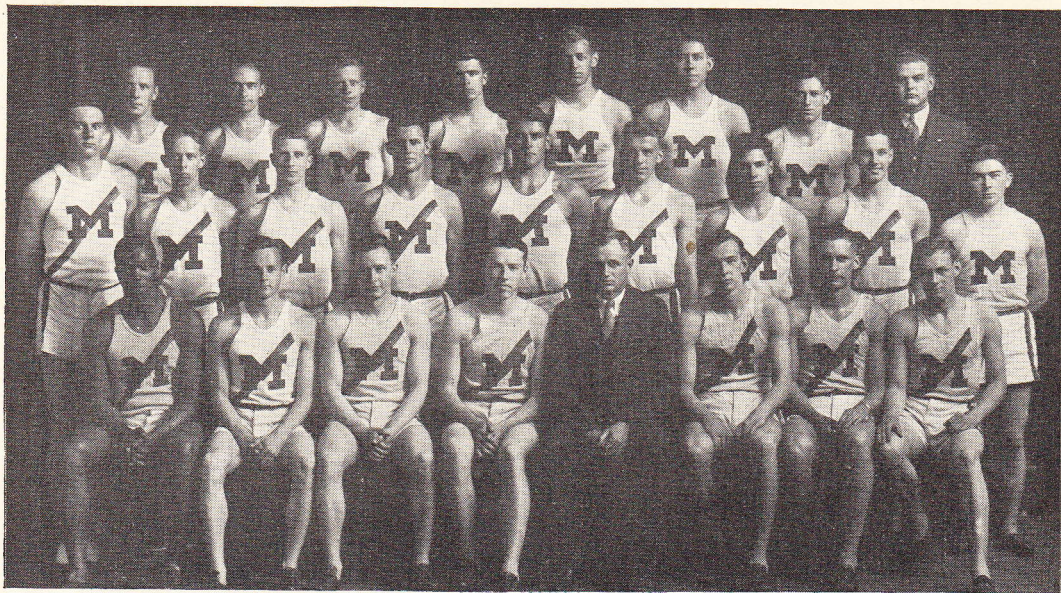

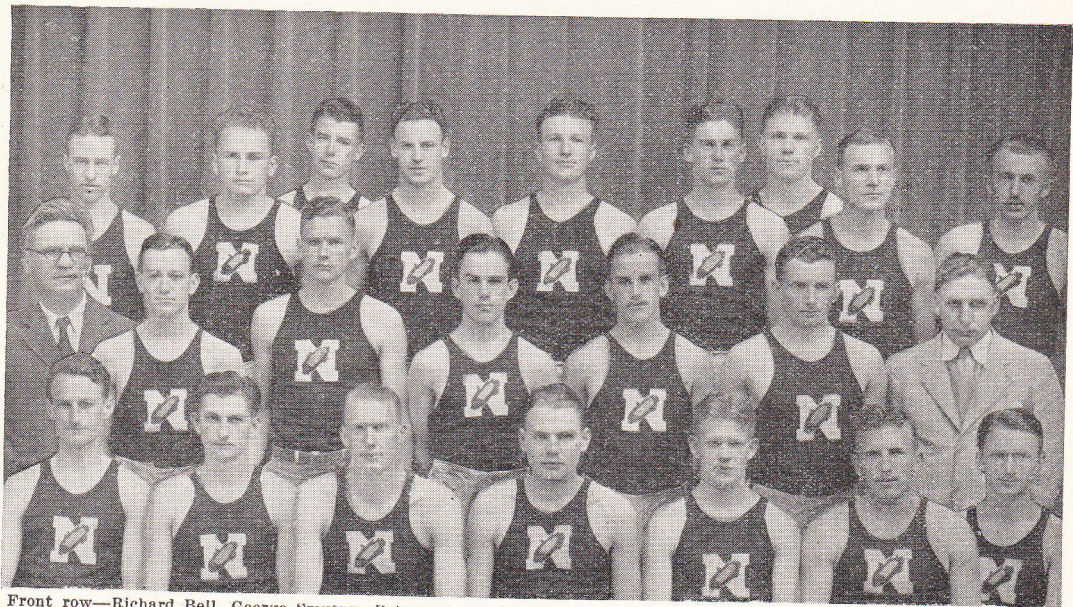

National Interscholastic Records

The National Federation of State High School Athletic Associations has appointed a committee on interscholastic records.
