Olympic Plans for U. S. Track and Field

On July 29, 1948 a vast throng of sports lovers from all parts of the world will gather in the Empire Stadium in London, and, amidst great fanfare and ceremony, the Fourteenth Olympic games will begin. It will have been twelve years since the finest athletes of the world have gathered together to engage in this great athletic event. The world has been torn by a bitter, destructive war and many of the wounds have yet to be healed, but to this great throng of competitors, it will mark the resuming of fine international competition; measuring their strength against the men of other nations, and those individuals fortunate enough to be winners, will truly be worthy of the name champion.

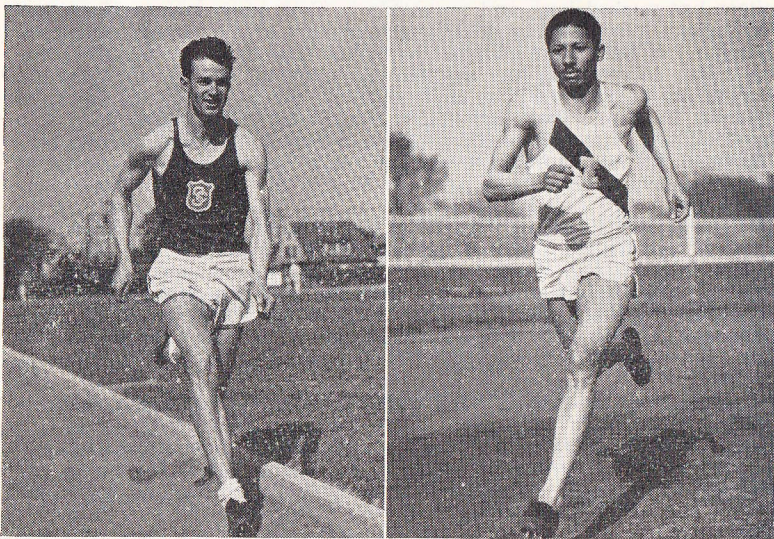
It is a tremendous job to select and prepare any team for this great event. There is no athletic contest held in the world where so many individuals are eager to try out and win the coveted honor of representing their country. Every amateur athlete is eligible, and it has been the job of the United States Olympic Track and Field Committee to see that every capable athlete who has possibilities, is given a just opportunity to make the team.

With this in view, the United States Olympic Track and Field Committee has worked long and arduously in their preparations. Sectional and regional meets will be held in various parts of the country under the leadership of both the AAU and the NCAA. The Army is making extensive plans to see that any soldier who possesses talent will have an opportunity to try out in the many different meets. The Navy has done likewise. From all these tryouts, the material will be channeled into two divisions. The college competitors will meet in the semi-final tryouts which will be the NCAA Track and Field Championship meet held at the University of Minnesota on June 18 and 19. The AAU Championships, which will also be constituted as a semi-final, will be held in Milwaukee July 2 and 3. From these two final meets will come the cream of the United States Track and Field material. They will meet in the final tryouts which will be held at Northwestern University, Evanston, Ill., July 9 and 10. To the winner of the first, second, and third places in each event in this meet, will go the honor of carrying the colors for the United States in London. The men selected will be sent immediately to New York where they will sail for London on July 15.

Judging from the fine marks made in last year's track and field competition, the United States will again be represented by a wonderful team. There are a few events, it is true, that we will have great competition from other countries throughout the world, but it is safe to say that the team which takes the field on July 30 for the opening event will be one of which any American can be proud.

As an officer of the NCAA, I am justly proud of the part that the athletes of our colleges and universities will play in this great contest. It is not an unlikely prediction that 75 per cent or more of the competi-

tors of the track and field team will come from our institutions of higher learning. With this honor also goes the direct responsibility of assuming our share of raising a large sum of money to help defray the expenses of our various teams to the games. The NCAA has pledged itself to raise \$150,000 to this cause. The Finance Committee, consisting of Harry Stuhldreher of Wisconsin; chairman; Al Masters of Stanford University; and H. Jamison Swarts of the University of Pennsylvania, has done a grand job in organizing and putting into operation a plan to raise this money. At the present time the goal has been more than half reached, but it will take the hearty cooperation of all our membership in helping the committee to attain its final objective. The Track and Field Committee, of which I have the honor of being chairman, and consisting of the following members: Herman J. Fischer, Chicago, Ill.; Emmett Brunson, Houston, Tex.; L. di Benedetto, New Orleans, La.; Wilbur H. Hutsell, Auburn, Ala.; Ward Haylett, Manhattan, Kans.; Larry Houston, Los Angeles, Calif.; Willis O. Hunter, Los Angeles, Calif.; Alfred R. Masters, Palo Alto, Calif.; Lloyd W. Olds, Ypsilanti, Mich.; Edward S. Parsons, Boston, Mass.; H. Jamison Swarts, Philadelphia, Pa., and Fred Travalena, Bronx, N. Y., has worked unrelentlessly to see that the tryouts and final meet be run in a faultless fashion. It is our desire to field the best track team in the Fourteenth Olympic games that has ever represented our country.

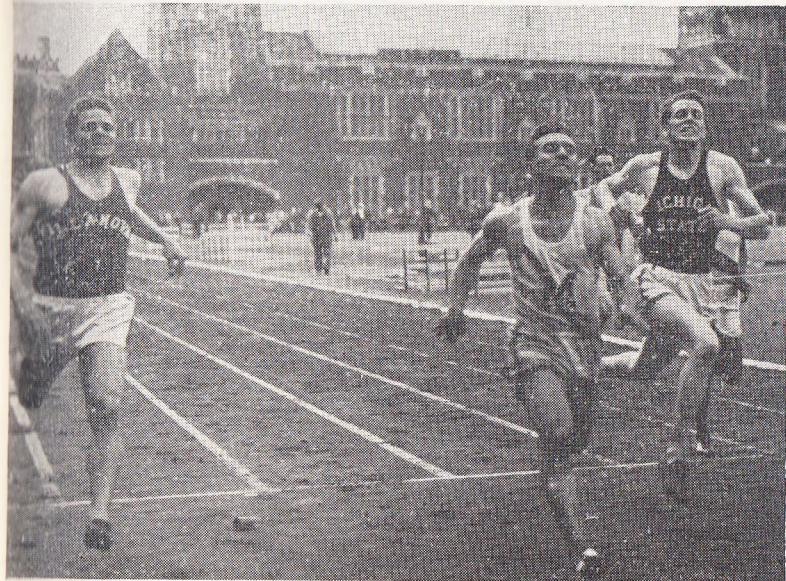

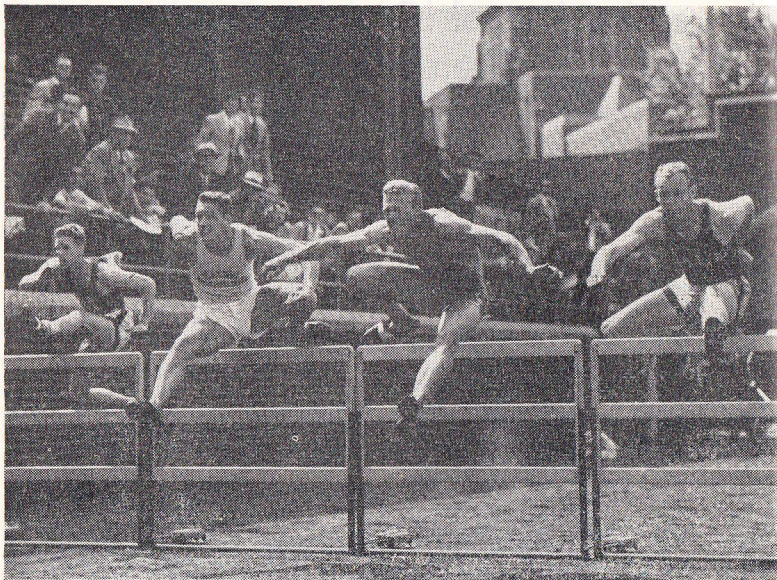

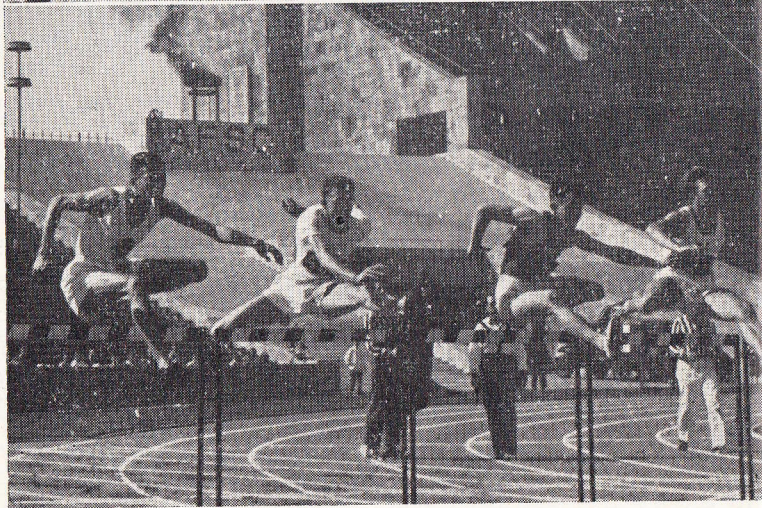

Track and Field in the European Command

Champions from the armed forces of eight nations—Belgium, Denmark, France, Great Britain, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway and United States—were brought together in the Second Annual Allied Forces Sports Council European Track and Field Championships, held in Olympic Stadium, Berlin, Germany, September 13-14, and sponsored by the United States. Again this meet was by far the outstanding sports event of the year in Europe, with an attendance of over 40,000.

All teams being at full strength made the competition keen. Ten meet records were broken.

The award for the outstanding athlete of the meet went to Jan Kleyn of the Netherlands for being a double winner and breaking his own previous meet records in 100 and 200 meter dashes.

The outstanding performances for the United States team were turned in in the 400 meter run by George Berger, holder of the meet record of 47.8; new meet records were set in the javelin throw at 58.42 meters by William Chynoweth, and the running high jump at 1.88 meters by Phillip Nichols.

The United States team was built from the champions of the European Command championships, held August 30-31 in Mannheim, Germany, in which teams from the ten subordinate commands participated. This same team gained additional experience on September 6 when it defeated the team from the Mediterranean Theater, again in the Mannheim Stadium.

Managing A Meet

By JIM KELLY

Track Coach, University of Minnesota

In preparing for a large meet, the first detail is taking care of the dressing facilities for the athletes and arranging for seats enabling the coaches to observe their men in action. Working track coaches usually express a strong preference for seats on the opposite side of the field from the finish lines. In order to give not only the coaches but spectators who sit on the end of the field and on the opposite side a clear view of the finish lines, all judges and timers should be placed in the stands when it is at all possible. This can be best arranged by having one set of judges in the stands next to the track and the other set on a specially constructed platform at the top of the stands. It has been our experience that the judges at the top of the stands have a much better view than the judges who are close to the track.

We have found at Minnesota that by establishing three different finish lines that you can satisfy more people who are looking for choice locations. In picking spots for your various field events, circles and takeoffs, you again can help both the athletes and the spectators by spreading out the events as much as possible. All circles and takeoffs should be constructed of well packed clay.

In selecting officials for field events, I think it is very important that men who have participated in these various events should be used. They should also be the type of official who is willing to do his job without projecting himself into the limelight but, at same time, have courage enough to enforce the rule on the few temperamental athletes who want to take more time than is fair to their fellow competitors.

It is very important that in arranging for any meet that special attention be paid to providing facilities for scorers, announcers, press and radio. We have found that by placing telephones near the various field events that we can pipe this information more rapidly than we could by runner.

Another detail is in the placing of our hurdles and the clearing of them after the event. There are always plenty of young athletes who would like to see your meet and by assigning them each a hurdle and placing them in charge of an older person you can set your hurdles and line them up in about three minutes. Your spectators usually get a kick out of this method of handling the hurdles.

In order to facilitate the applications for any new records created, at least three anemometers should be on hand so that they can be used for the races and also the broad jump. A supply of both National Collegiate and World's Record blanks should be at the scorers' desk so that they may be filled out immediately, taking care of all the red tape that is necessary to apply for a record.

We, as coaches, can help considerably if we get our entries in on time with the names and first names of all contestants printed or typewritten so that the correct spelling gets into the program, and also in cooperating with the Games Committee by furnishing as much information on outstanding athletes as possible.

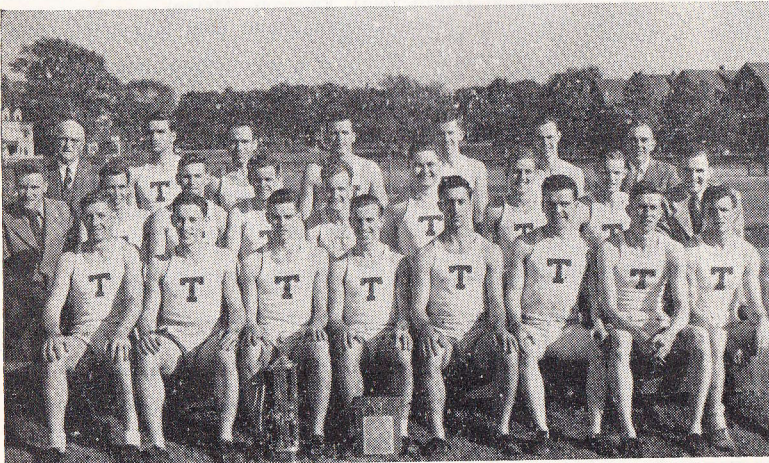

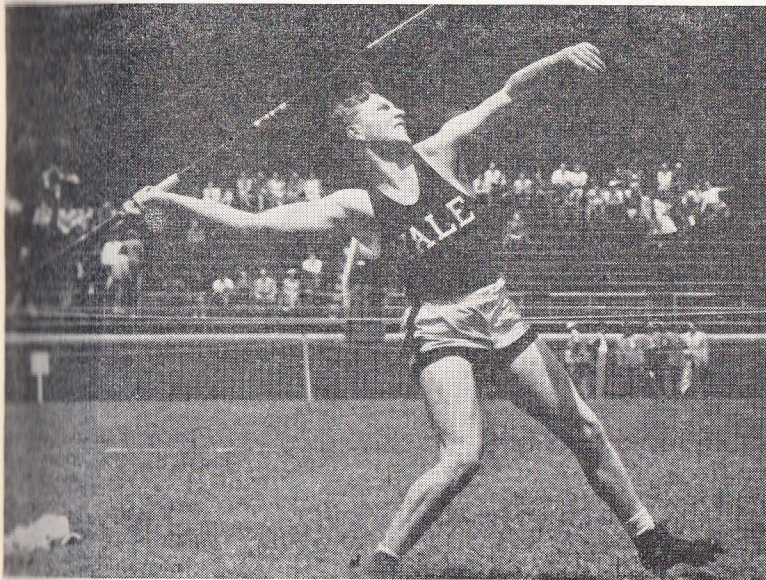

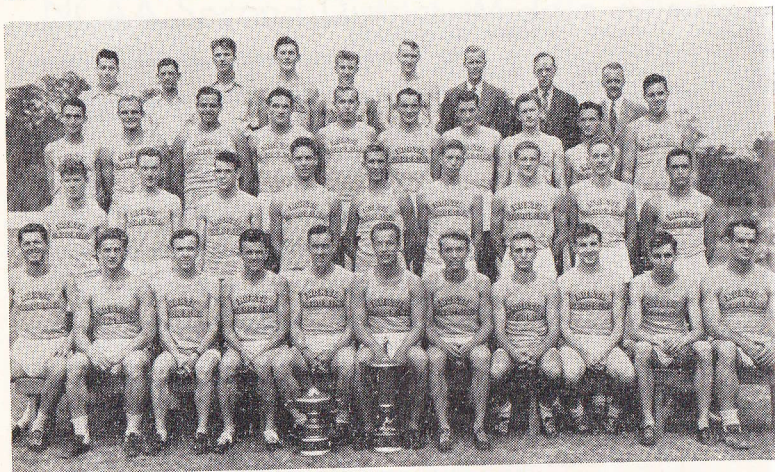

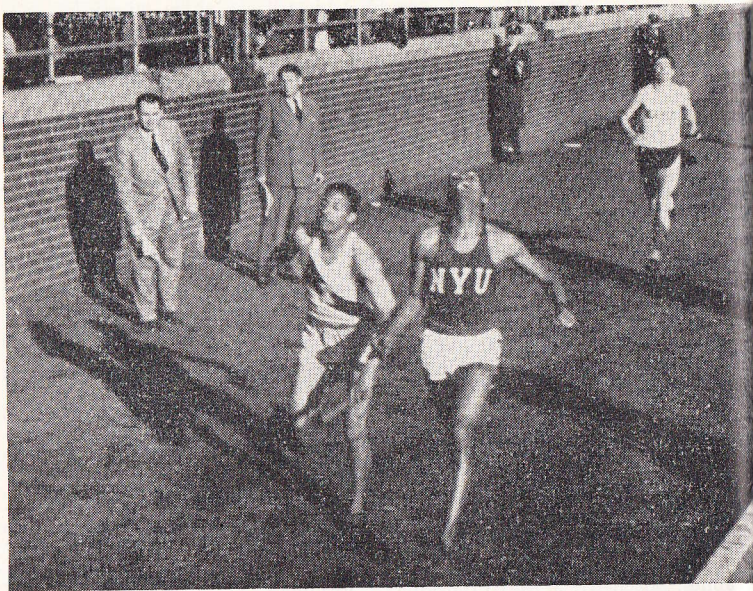

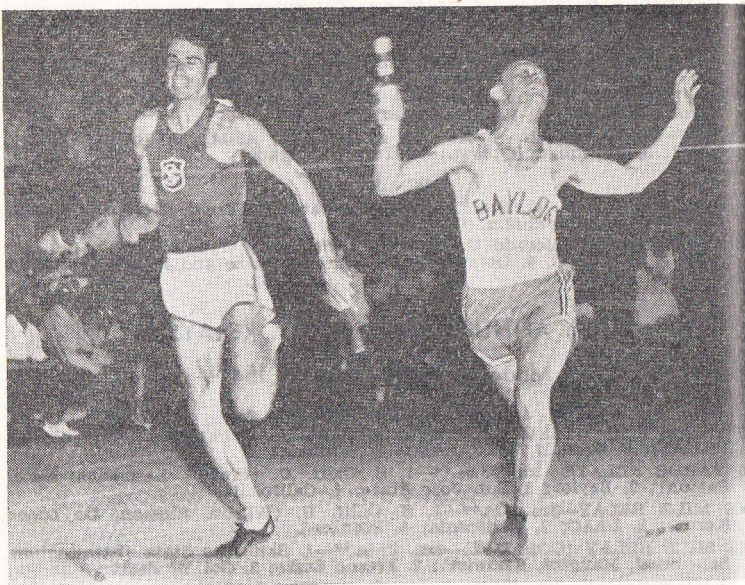

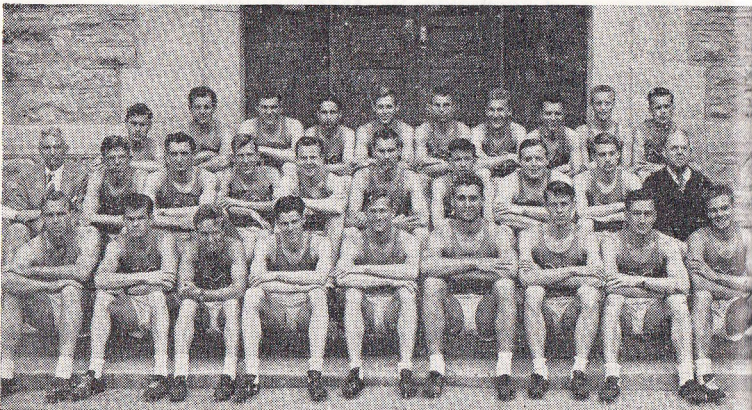
