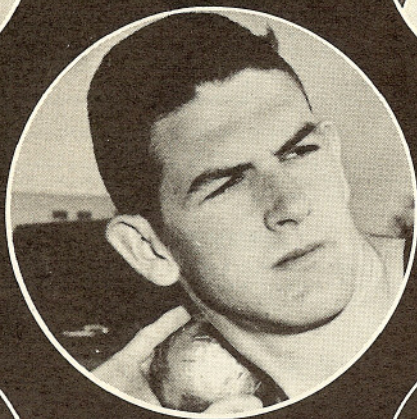

1963 IN REVIEW

Seven individuals in eight events and two relay teams recorded all-time bests in 1963 but not included in this category is Randy Matson, of Pampa, Tex., who goes down in the books as one of the true super-stars in prep track and field history.

Matson became the best combination shot put and discus competitor with the second and third best marks ever recorded in the two events. Matson did 66'10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " with the shot and 193'1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in the discus. Only Dallas Long (69'3") and Bob Stocker (195'4") and Karl Johnstone (194'5") have ever done better. The giant Texan also did 60'6" with the 16 pound shot and 169'7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " with the college weight disc. Only Long (61'0 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") and Archie Harris (175'8") have ever done better.

All-time individual bests were stenciled into the record books by Mike Ryan (Wilcox, Santa Clara, Calif.) 9:09.8 in two mile, Tracy Smith (Arcadia, Calif.) 9:30.5 in 3000-meter steeplechase, Dennis Carr (Lowell, Whittier, Calif.) 1:49.2 in 880, Marc Savage (Claremont, Calif.) 15'3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in the pole vault, Mike Woods (Manual Arts, Los Angeles, Calif.) 51'8" in triple jump, Del McNabb (Lake Charles, La.) 231'1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in javelin, Moses Mayfield (Bok Tech, Philadelphia, Pa.) 31:15.6 for six miles, and Alvin Mann (Edison, Fresno, Calif.) twice did 18.3 in 180 yard low hurdles to equal the national mark.

Archbishop Stepinac High School of White Plains, N.Y., clocked 7:49.3 in the two-mile relay and Proviso West of Hillside, Ill., 17:42.0 for the four-mile baton event with a junior, two sophs and a freshman.

Stepinac's team was composed of Kevin Malone (2:00.7), John Lamb (1:56.3), Ray Donaton (1:55.5) and Brian Hernon (1:56.8) and their record came a week after New Trier of Winnetka, Ill., had clocked 7:49.4, also under the old standard set by Roosevelt of Dayton, O., at 7:49.9 in 1962.

Proviso West had ninth grader Ed Katz start its record run with a 4:34.8 and followed it up with 10th grader Craig Grant (4:23.9), 10th grader Bruce Bowman (4:22.8) and junior Jim Letterer (4:20.5).

Perhaps the most amazing athlete of all was a sophomore who gives the future a bright glow. Jim Ryun of Wichita East, Wichita, Kans., smashed soph class standards in three events--1:53.6 in 880, 4:07.8 in the mile, and 9:13.8 for two miles. The latter two rate as the second best ever recorded on the prep level. Ralph Gamez (Foothill, Hayward, Calif.) shattered Mike Ryan's international age 15 record when he ran two miles in 9:13.2 and is another talented sophomore to watch. He did it in December, behind Ryan's 9:09.8.

Another great sophomore prospect is discus tosser Bob Hawke of Butte, Mont., whose 182'10" toss last spring bettered the previous best by a 10th grader by more than 10 ft. Eric McCaskill (Huntington, Newport News, Va.) and Barry Milburn (Overbrook, Philadelphia, Pa.) tied the 14.4 soph record made by John Roderick (Highland Park, Dallas Tex.) in 1960.

The freshmen and juniors did some record breaking too with 880, two mile, high jump and broad jump marks falling on the fresh level.

Stanley Albright, 6'1" and 160-pound ninth grader at Harry E. Davis Jr. High School in Cleveland, O., leaped 6'6" to set a new high jump mark. The leap by the 15-year-old jumping jack was no fluke as he also posted 6'5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " and 6'5" marks during the outdoor season.

The broad jump standard went to Johnny Johnson of Pacific Grove, Calif., consistently over 23' and who did 23'10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " against a wind in his final meet. That mark cracked the previous freshman best of 23'10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " set in 1953 by Junior Tate of Casa Grande, Ariz. It was the oldest fresh record in the books.

The other ninth grade record was set by Eddie Davis, Hueneme High School of Oxnard, Calif., who ran 880 yards in 1:57.4.

Big news from the junior class ranks was the sensational 880 by Robert Hose of Madison High School in San Diego, Calif., who ran 1:51.7.

One competitor equaled the junior class mark of 9.5 for the 100, Frank McDonald of Lincoln High in Tallahassee, Fla.

The event producing the most records was the 880 where each class has a new mark.

The pole vault had the most improvement on a mass scale, as 32 preps took advantage of the glass pole to get over 14 ft., more than all previous years had produced.

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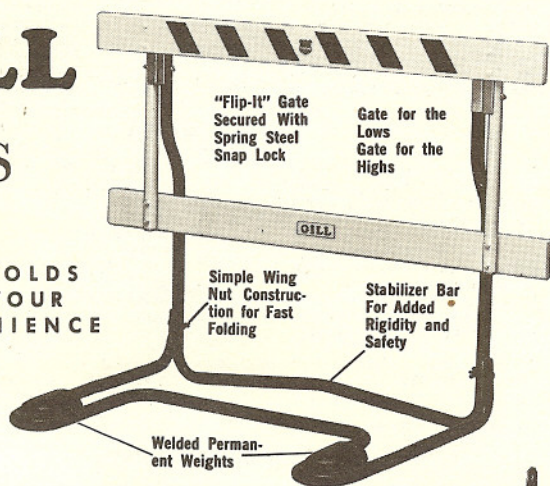

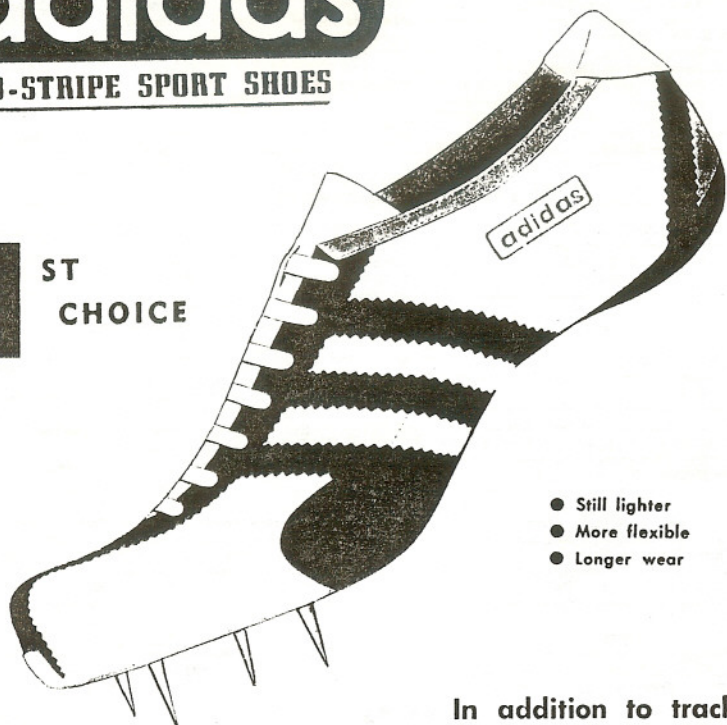
