Results

Include first and last name of at least the first three competitors in each event, along with hometown or team affiliation, time or distance of each competitor listed, type of track (dirt or all-weather), wind conditions (the more specific the better), height of hurdles, weight of implements (shot, discus, etc.). Also include heat or qualifying round marks (if better than final mark) and birthdates on top athletes would be helpful for best performance lists.

News

General interest items (in contrast to news merely of your team or of one individual) are more useful. We want material on both **boys** and **girls** (such as schedules of upcoming events, new teams or programs, background info on area, athletes, etc.), especially from areas which haven't gotten much space before.

This is what you can expect from us now and in the coming season:

This issue (Fall Edition) came out later than planned. We encountered difficulties in assembling the material needed for the year-end Age Group lists, particularly in the boys section. Besides the results of the combined standings of the Postal Meet of Miles was very late and we hated to come out without it. But there it is, and we hope that you like it. All Fall Editions will be similar in content and in normal conditions should be in your hands by December.

The next issue (winter edition) will highlight the Year-in-Review Boys Divisional highlights and Junior Women Rankings- as well as all the National X-Country meets. This edition should be mailed out by the end of February

The Spring edition will inform you about dates and places of all upcoming National meets and their qualifying standards, plus a most extensive Calendar of the season. This issue will come out in early May.

August will be the month of the summer Edition. We hope to have all the results, highlights and photos of all the Nationals for that issue.

We are also coming out with the 7th Edition of our very popular Annuals. Realistically speaking, we believe these handbooks will be ready by March.

In the Annuals we highlight the best performers of the year in all standard events. As the athletes are classified by birth years (Girls Annual) and by specific Age (Boys Annual) information regarding birthdates is most critical.

Clubs, Meet directors, Junior Olympics officials, schools and others will or have received requests concerning birthdate information on selected athletes. A prompt answer will be highly welcomed, as our deadline depends on it. The sooner we receive the information, the sooner the books will be out in print.

We strongly urge all clubs and other responsible parties to mail us their roster of athletes. This gesture will insure that their members will be included in the the Annuals. The young athletes will appreciate the favor. And so would we.

NATIONAL JUNIOR OLYMPICS CHAMPIONSHIPS

LINCOLN, NEBRASKA - AUGUST 14

A muscular 18 year old sprinter bound for Louisiana State University on a football scholarship and a perky 16 year old brunette destined for greatness discovered the biggest gold mines in the track & field events of the AAU-Sears National Junior Olympics at the University of Nebraska.

WILLIE TURNER, a New Orleans athlete whose physique could qualify for a bodybuilding magazine, won three gold medals to highlight the boys competition. He zipped the 100 in 9.7, whisked a 21.7/220 in the rain and anchored the Region 9 (Gulf Coast States) record-setting 440 relay which clocked 42.2.

JENNIE GORHAM, a pig-tailed high school junior who could moonlight for milk commercials, was the standout in the girls competition, becoming the first female in NJO history to capture three individual gold medals.

The North Kansas City sensation flashed definite Olympic potential, winning the 100 on opening day and authoring gold medal efforts in the 220 and 440 within a 45 minute span on closing day.

It'll be two more years before Gorham packs her bags for college, but recruiters already are drooling. As a sophomore, she led her North Kansas City team to the class 2-A Missouri state championships, scoring 40 points by winning the 100, 220, 440 and long jump.

TOMMY MARTIN of Evansville, Ind., Memorial High School sprinted the opening quarter of his national championship record 1:50.94 half-mile in 49 seconds flat, causing most timers and officials to do a double take on their stop-watches. "Going off in 49, I was lucky to make it," Martin admitted. "I was crawling at the end. All I could think about was keeping my arms moving and praying nobody would cut up on me."

An 18 year old high jumper who never practices and a 17 year old pole vaulter who has battled seemingly unsurmountable odds to compete shared in the highlights.

BILL HICE of Oakland, CA, who trains on a 10-speed racing bike to and from a McDonald's hamburger franchise where he works as a swing shift manager, tied the NJO championship high jump record with a leap of 7-0. "I don't have time to practice after school," Hice related. "I may practice once a week at the most, but I never jump except in meets." He had jumped 7-2 earlier.

JEFF BUCKINGHAM, who had just turned 17 and has a career best of 16-1 3/4, set an NJO championship record by clearing 16-0 in the pole vault.

It's remarkable Buckingham is able to compete, let alone excel in national competition. When he was eleven years old, he camped out in his backyard with two brothers and two friends. They fell asleep shortly after midnight, failing to turn out the gas lantern inside the tent. No one quite knows what happened, but a fire started while the young campers slept, with Jeff suffering burns over 65 percent of his body, with third degree burns on his right calf, thigh and arm that required skin grafts. "I almost didn't make it," Buckingham said. "The next night, my heart stopped a couple of times."

HERB WILLS, an outstanding distance prospect from Tallahassee, FL, ran away with the 2-mile title, after having placed 5th last year as a 16 year-old.

3. In the sprints, hurdles and long jump, wind assistance should be reported (wind-gauge readings are best, but wind estimates help).
4. Hurdle races should have hurdle height and distance noted.
5. The weight of shot must be noted and some indication that all implements (incl. discus and javelin) have been checked for legal weight and dimensions will help validate marks.
