missed by just one-tenth of a second of tying the Frenchman on last June 4 when he won the mile at the Compton Invitational in 3:53.7. That night, he said "I should have had it."

Ryun's time Saturday for 1,500 meters was 3:36.1, the second fastest ever for the distance and established a new American record. The old American mark of 3:38.1 was set by Tom O'Hara of Loyola, at New Brunswick, N.J., on June 27, 1964.

It also marked the ninth time that Ryun has broken four minutes in his brief career.
