

**BELMONT** — John Radetich of San Carlos High won The Great High Jump Duel here Saturday, but neither he nor Pittsburg's Don Pierce got close to their goal of 7-feet.

Radetich won at 6-8 and barely missed on two of his three tries at 6-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ . Pierce the first person ever to jump 7-feet in a high school meet, had trouble all day and failed at 6-8 after making 6-6 on his last try.

Neither jumper was ecstatic about the takeoff apron at Carlmont and both indicated they are looking forward to resuming their dual next Saturday at the Davis Picnic meet, where the jumping area and the competition will be better.

Marion Anderson of El Cerrito, third man in the much-publicized duel here Saturday, cleared only 6-2.

El Cerrito won the fourth annual Carlmont Invitational Relays with 65 points, followed by Los Altos (51), Pittsburgh (45), Carlmont (34), Berkeley (30) and San Carlos (22).

El Cerrito set meet records in the 480 shuttle high hurdles (62.1 seconds, an average of 15.5 per man) the 720 yard shuttle low hurdles (1:22.3 for a 20.6 average) and discus (610-5 $\frac{1}{2}$  for a 152-7 average) and Pittsburg tied the meet record in the high jump (24 feet, 6-feet per man).

Top efforts by Carlmont and San Carlos relay teams were the former's first place in the eight-mile event, and San Carlos' second to Berkeley in the four mile.

John Lilly of San Carlos ran a 50.1 quartermile opening leg in the mile relay; the Dons' Bruce Hull ran a 4:26.6 mile; and Carlmont's Gordon (Buddy) Crowell was timed in 19.7 for his 180-yard leg in the low hurdles.
