# Burlingame Wins MPL Track Title

Burlingame High School's track team, riding strong through the season, today easily reached a long-sought objective as they triumphed.

After two frustrating seasons of playing "stars the week," the Panthers today reign as champions of the Mid-Piedmont League, an achievement they crystallized by winning today's MPL title at Greenwood Hillside High School.

The Panthers, who had marched through their dual meet season without a loss, scored 40 points to easily outpace the rest of the pack. In so doing, the Burlingame juggernaut easily won the title it had shared for two previous seasons.

San Mateo, which had a shot at being the Panthers' closest rival, finished a distant second with 20 points while Chabot finished third with 10.

Randy West, San Mateo Coach's head hunter and probably

the finest to ever run for the Panthers, led Burlingame in its 100 with time in the 1:25 and low version of his specialty, having an exceptional clearance of 11.1 and 18.7, respectively.

Totally, West also anchored the Panthers' victorious 800 relay team in the final meeting event of the day.

And now, a word about the weather, sports fans.

If Hillsdale High School is a good place to stage a track meet, this event for national should be held in Menlo Park's Regency.

An overcast, chilling winter afternoon began, at 4:30 p.m. The wind, blowing from the northwest, lulled the runners with break well beyond 3000 of the North Star, setting the standard of the distance competitors as eight minutes and 10 seconds among the blue-eyed jays.

And if the miserable weather conditions weren't bad enough, the hazy side of the meet seriously was.

Even if the more direct conditions had been just, the meet dragged on miserably where it finally ended 7 1/2 hours

later. The rain, which began at 4:30 p.m., did not start until 4 o'clock, when the wind turned east of the three-jaw jutting wedge. Both and spectators were at a minimum.

One lad who beat the wind and weather is one of the Bay's best runners was San Mateo's Ted Laska, who worked through the rain-soaked in 1:10 to beat his opponent by nearly one-half minute.

Other good marks, under the conditions, were a 1:55 1/2

mile by MEU's Randy White, a 4:10 mile by Burlingame's Greg Aronson and Jim Kaufman's 10.1 quarter for Dupont.

In the field, Steve D'Amico, 11 feet by the champion, San Mateo's Don Jordan won the long jump with a leap of 20-3/4 and MEU's Greg Carlson took the shot put with a 32-4 leap.

Burlingame got one first place that could have been considered as such when Gary Finerman outlogged the field to win the 100.

MEU was the Class B meet with 21 points while San Mateo took the C division with 11. Jim Bell scored 21 points for Hillsdale in the B meet.

The top five finishers in yesterday's meet, among the many and Class B competitors, qualified for the Region I meet that will be held next Saturday at Queen High School in Palo Alto.

That meet will be the first in a series of competitive tests for the California State meet in June.
