Wildcat Duo Tops Track

Watsonville's two-pronged running attack of Mike Williamson and Bob Scurich hold down two best efforts apiece to pace the current Central Coast listings of top prep track and field efforts.

The Wildcat duo claims every fastest time from 100 yards through the mile with the exception of the 440-yard dash where Los Altos' Bill Chapman is kingpin at 48.5.

Scurich hasn't lowered his pace-setting clockings in the mile or half-mile for nearly three weeks, but his mile time of 4:17.7 is still almost seven seconds ahead of runner-up efforts. His 880 standard of 1:54.8 is 1.8 seconds better than Fred Jones of Seaside.

Williamson, whose wind-aided 9.7 in the 100 has not yet been equalled, reclaimed leadership in the 220 with a 21.6 at the King City Relays.

Williamson accounted for one of only four changes among firsts from the previous listing of top times.

San Carlos high jumper John Radetich, who missed clearing seven feet by a slight bump of the bar with his trailing leg, moved into first in that event with a 6-9½ effort.

King City's Don Wells moved into pole vault leadership after a jump of 13-9½ and Andrew Hill's Dale Carlin put the shot 60-3½ to replace Fremont's Steve Wilhelm.

Only school other than Wat-

sonville to land more than one top effort is Los Altos, with triple jumper Denny Rodgers joining quarter-miler Chapman.

The Knights, winners of the Andrew Hill Invitational, show the best over-all balance, landing 14 spots throughout the listings. Thirty-eight schools are represented.
