Cards' Byron Wilson Runs 9.7 100; Wins Both Century And 220 Dash

Hollister — Although most times were disappointing at the CCS Division 3 track meet here Saturday night, the outcome was as expected with Watsonville dominating the field in lightweight and varsity competition.

The Wildcats tallied 48½ points to bring home victory with ease while Seaside 37, King City 31, Santa Cruz 27, Monterey 24, Live Oak 11, Gil-

Santa Cruz' Byron Wilson moved up another large step in the 100 yard dash, winning his event in 9.7 seconds. He also received a first place in the 220 with a time of 22.2.

Cardinal Ron Vellutini cleared 13'0" in the pole vault, as did Don Wells of King City, but Vellutini got second place on misses. Vellutini was also third in the 220. The Card relay team was first in the 800 relay with a time of 1:33.1. King City came in ahead of Santa Cruz but was disqualified on an illegal baton pass.

Greg Larson picked up Santa Cruz' only other varsity points with a fourth place in the 440.

San Lorenzo Valley's 9 points came on a first place 6'2½"

high jump by Dennis McCullough, and a third in the discus by Dave Neal. Cougar Pat Verulli, who faired quite well at the Dads' Club relays was scratched from competition.

Soquel received its only point with a fifth place in the mile run by Al Hall. Hall was So-

quel's only entry in the tough meet.

Next week, the qualifying trials from Saturday's meet go to Palo Alto to compete in the Central Coast Section Track and Field meet. The first four places qualify for next week's meet, thereby allowing five Santa Cruz area athletes, plus the Cardinal 800 relay team, for the meet.

Since Saturday's meet was the first CCS Division 3 meet, all first places are automatically region 3 records.

Wildcats Top Track

HOLLISTER — Favored Watsonville nabbed a meet-high 15 spots in Saturday's Central Coast Sectional track championships while amassing 48½ points for the Region III title Saturday night.

Two of the berths were given, via vote of meet officials, to the Wildcats. The positions went to sprinter Mike Williamson, who pulled a muscle in a preliminary heat of the 220.

Williamson garnered spots in the 100 and 220, both won by Byron Wilson of Santa Cruz with wind-aided times of 9.7 and 21.4, respectively.

Only person to qualify in three events was Watsonville's Lynn Jackson, in the low hurdles, quarter-mile and long jump.

Teammate Bob Scurich won the mile in 4:25.0, one of his slower times in recent weeks.

King City's John Romans captured the 440 in 49.9.
