# San Diego Prep Breaks U.S. Record

SAN DIEGO—San Diego High long jumper Doyle Steel bettered the national record Friday night, leaping 25-5 3/4 in the San Diego Section CIF championships at Balboa Stadium.

Steel's record jump came on his final attempt after it appeared Lincoln's Lewis King had won the event at 24-5-1/4. The mark eclipsed Pacific Grove's John Johnson's standard of 25-4 3/4 set last year.

# State, National Records Fall in CIF Track Finals

San Diego CIF track and field performers enjoyed a banner night Friday as they set one national, two state and four CIF records in the sixth annual CIF finals at Balboa Stadium.

Foremost among the record breakers were Chula Vista's ace miler, Tim Danielson and San Diego's Doyle Steel.

**DANIELSON** broke his own previous mark in the mile, when he broke the tape in 4:06.2 to establish the new state time. He holds the official state meet record of 4:08, set last year in the state finals.

Steel eclipsed all schoolboy marks in the nation with a long jump effort of 25-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ .

Steel's distance eliminated the national mark of 25-4 $\frac{3}{4}$  set last year by John Johnson of Pacific Grove, Calif., and was better by more than eight inches than any other San Diego prep jump in history.

Lincoln High School took the team title with a total of 65 points. The Hornets were trailed by Chula Vista and Granite Hills with 15 points each.

**THE CLASS B** championship was taken by San Diego, while Lincoln and Grossmont tied for the Class C trophy.

In addition to Danielson's and Steel's records, El Cajon's Armando Valencia broke the old mark in the two-mile run with a clocking of 9:10.8; Lin-

coln's Dave Edward beat the old standard of :14.4 in the 120-yard high hurdles with a time of :14.2; Harold Greenwood of Morse blasted a new height in the high jump with a leap of 6-8 $\frac{1}{4}$ , and Jonny Mack Ellis of Lincoln ran the 220 furlong in :21.4.

Terry Rogers knocked two-tenths of a second off his previous season's best in the 880, touring the half-mile in 1:51.6.

The top two finishers in each event qualified for the California State finals next Saturday in Berkeley.
