

Berkeley High Carries Off C. I. F. Athletic Meet

BERKELEY HIGH SCHOOL won the fifth annual track and field meet of the north coast section of the California Interscholastic Federation with 48 points. Oakland Technical High School ranked second with 27½ points. The meet was held for the purpose of selecting men for the State championships to be held next month, and the first three men in each event are to qualify.

Five records went by the board in the meet. The half-mile record was lowered by Pearce of Berkeley from 2:05:3 to 2:05. The high jump was raised by Muller of Technical from 5 ft. 9 in. Miller also shattered the broad-jump record, hanging up a distance of 21 ft. 7½ in. In the javelin throw Smith of Berkeley threw 153 ft. 4 in. In the 12-pound shot put Mathews (120 pounds) from Berkeley, made 41 ft. 9 in.

BERKELEY HIGH SCHOOL ANNEXES TRACK HONORS

The athletes of the Alameda county schools after struggling for five years finally won the high school track and field championship of the North Coast section of the California Interscholastic Federation yesterday afternoon on the University of California track.

Berkeley high school won the championship with many points to spare, Oakland Tech, coming second and Oakland High third. Records were smashed in the half mile, high jump, broad jump, eight-pound shot put and the javelin throw.

Shepherd of Fremont winning first place in both of the sprints and second in the running broad jump carried off the individual honors of the day, scoring 13 points. Muller of Tech, displayed great form in both the high and broad jumps, breaking both the records, while Pearce of Berkeley carrying off both the mile and half starred for the winners. Helm captured ten points for Oakland.

The boys from the college town have a remarkably well balanced team and were in the best of physical condition. Le Hane, though breaking his record made in the javelin last year, was defeated by his teammate, Smith.

San Jose, which won the meet for the past four years, had to be content with fourth position. With one or two exceptions, all the races were closely contested.
