record held by the Trojan team of last year at 7 minutes 47.8 seconds when they ran the distance in 7:44.3.

Olympic Club's Martin Biles had vengeance on Stanford's Bud Held for a previous defeat in the javelin when he tossed the spear 228 feet 11 inches against Held's 220 feet 10 inches.

The Trojan half-mile relay team of Pasquali, Frazier, Stocks and Patton bettered the old world record of 1 minute 25 seconds for the third time in seven days as they ran the distance in 1:24.9. But their latest effort stands as a new meet mark only, because they had run 1:24.4 at Fresno a week ago and 1:24 flat at Los Angeles only last night.

Again Patton didn't appear to be trying too hard. We "caught" him in 20.8 seconds for his 220.

Pittsburg's John Henry Johnson proved the star of the prep division as he established a new meet record of 57 feet 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches for the 12-pound shotput and also placed second in the 100 yards and broad jump contests.

The old meet prep shot record was 54 feet 4 inches, held by Wilhoite of Merced, who was second to Johnson today at 54:4 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

Lowell High's Jim Plessas added the California Relays title to the West Coast Relays honors he won last week as he captured the century in 10 seconds flat to tie the meet record. Plessas was fourth in the broad jump as Stockton's Garravanta won at 22 feet 6 inches.

California frosh medley relay men — Juette, Lucchesi, Speiden and Lew Olive—set a new meet record for the jaysee-frosh class at 10 minutes 33.4 seconds as compared to the old 10:51.8 by Bakersfield Junior College.

Plessas came back to anchor the Lowell mile relay team to an 80 yard victory in new prep meet record time of 3 minutes 24.8 seconds.
