TULARE HIGH TAKES SAN JOAQUIN MEET

BAKERSFIELD, May 4.—Tulare High School won the San Joaquin Valley track meet here today amassing 30 points against Bakersfield's second place, with 27, in a meet which established six new valley records for C. I. F. track meets. Fresno finished third in the meet with 22; Hanford, fourth, with 21; Visalia, fifth, with 14; Taft, sixth, with 11; Porterville, seventh, with 10 1-2, and then Kingsburg, with 5; Selma, with 4 1-2; Merced, with 3, and Parlier, with 2 points, in the order named.

Marty, sensational high jumper of Fresno, set a new record by clearing the bar at 6ft. 3in. Shehtanian of Tulare set a new record for the broad jump, with a leap of 22ft. 7 1-4in. York of Taft, in the Class B shotput, sent the shot 55ft. 1-8in. Winn of Taft tossed the discus 132ft. 6 1-2in. and the Bakersfield relay team turned in the 880 in 1m. 32 3-5s., all these marks being new valley records.
