

Sacramento High *Wins Track Meet*

YUBA CITY (Cal.), May 4.—(AP)—Sacramento High School won the track and field meet of the Northern Section California Interscholastic Federation here today by annexing 35½ points. The meet was taken by the margin of the relay race. Turlock and Lodi were alternating with Sacramento in leadership to the final event.

Thirty-six high schools entered the meet, but only the following scored: Sacramento, 35½; Turlock, 28; Lodi, 26; Oakdale, 15; Vallejo, 14; Woodland, 7; Stockton, 6 1-5; Chico, 5; Williams, 5; San Juan, 5; Sonora, 4½; Yuba City, 1 1-5; Los Molinos, 1; Modesto, ½.

The first two men in each event and the Sacramento relay team will go to the final meet in Los Angeles.

In individual work Hoobyar of Turlock was high point man with 12½ points and his teammate, Sterner, had one. Roblof of Sacramento scored ten. Spurr of Williams made 11 feet, six inches in the pole vault and sprained his ankle doing so. He won the event without another try.

Sacramento high captured four first places, alone worth 25 points, one second, one third and five fourths to run up its winning total in the N. S. C. I. F. meet in Yuba City Saturday.

Turlock took three firsts, a pair of seconds and two fourths. Lodi, finishing third, scored no firsts out counted heavily in seconds and thirds, taking seven of the latter, at two digits each.
