MOUNTAIN VIEW PLACES SECOND; WELLS SETS NEW HALF MILE MARK

Springing a surprise, Coach Doug Helm's Los Gatos high school track team yesterday won the Santa Clara Valley league unlimited championship at Spartan field.

Scoring 51 points, the winners beat out the Mountain View Eagles favorites to win, by 16 points. Fremont high school of Sunnyvale was third, 23½ points behind the leaders.

SANTA CLARA FOURTH.

Santa Clara high placed fourth with 19 tallies, while Live Oak and Campbell high's men took the two last positions with 7½ and 3 points respectively.

Wells of Los Gatos turned out to be the only man to live up to pre-meet expectations in the record-breaking line, as he did the mile run in 4 minutes 51.3 seconds, thereby clipping 4.5 seconds off the former record.

Other league records had been expected to go by the boards, but the windy weather proved to be too large a handicap for most of the men.

COMPETITION CLOSED.

With the completion of yesterday's meet, valley league athletes closed their 1932 season. Fremont high proved to be outstanding in lightweight track, as Coach Geddes' men took both the 110 and 130 division titles.

Mountain View high took the 120 class pennant and the Los Gatos barged into the winning class with their victory yesterday afternoon.

The meet was staged under the sponsorship of the Junior Chamber of Commerce as part of their Fiesta Olympic program.
