

HOLLISTER WINS ALL THREE DIVISIONS OF LEAGUE MEET; BASSETT BREAKS OWN RECORD

Hollister high school staged a big field meet yesterday at the expense of the other Coast Counties Athletic League schools, winning all three divisions of the annual league track and field competition. This is the first time in league history that any school ever won all divisions of the meet.

Thanks to the protest of Coach Harry Shipkey of Salinas over Wirz and Silva, two Hollister lightweights, they were made to compete in the unlimited division and the two of them were responsible for Hollister's surprise victory over Salinas. Wirz won the two dashes and tied for second in the broad jump. Silva won the low hurdles. Both ran on the winning relay team.

Hollister nosed out the King City lightweights by the scant margin of a quarter of a point. Watsonville, expected to be strong in this division, was handicapped by the illness of an ineligible of several likely point winners.

Ralph Bassett, Santa Cruz boy who set a new record in the shot put last season, had tough luck and broke his shoulder in football season. He had not been able to even approach his former performance all season. Yesterday, however, he came through with a mighty heave of 49 ft. 11½ in. to break his own record.

The meet was poorly conducted and disputes were many. In the lightweight discus event, Bradley Lynn of Santa Cruz was required to take all his throws, one after the other, as rapidly as he could, in order that he might compete in the 100 yard dash. He failed to get off a good heave and did not place. He had been consistently bettering the league record in previous meets.

Lynn came through to win the 220 yard dash in surprising time. Philipson won the 630 yard run. He had the pole position, took an early lead and held it throughout the race and coming into the home stretch fought off the challenge of Dent, Monterey boy, who was coming up fast.

Bassett's mark was the only new record set in the unlimited division. There was a wind which cut the time in the longer races. Hal Youngman of Monterey, handling the starting of the races, called the boys back in nearly every event, making the times slower.
