

SKINNER LEADS MANUAL SQUAD TO TRACK WIN

Hollywood Fourth, Fairfax
Seventh in Annual City
League Contests

Led by its one man track team and captain, Don Skinner, Manual Arts captured the City League track and field championship yesterday at Los Angeles High School before a capacity crowd. With a leap of 23 feet 6 5-8 inches, the Toller star broke the broad jump record of 23 feet 4 3-4 inches, took second to Jones, Jefferson sprinter, in the 220, and ran the anchor lap on the winning relay team. His performance enabled Manual to beat out Jeff for the title, 45 1-2 to 37 3-7.

Running to form, L. A. High took third place with 20 6-7 points followed by Hollywood with 18. Fairfax could place no better than seventh with 15 points. Other scores were: Poly, 16 3-7; Fremont, 15 5-14; Garfield, 7; Lincoln, 2; Roosevelt, 2; Franklin, 3-7; and Belmont, 0.

L. A. One-Two In Hurdles

Los Angeles, with Bob McWhinney and Sam Jacobson, placed one, two in the low hurdles, when Bob McGaughey of Fairfax, who was leading, tripped over the last hurdle to take fifth. McGaughey nosed out Lloyd Olson of Manual in the highs.

The quarter mile proved a "local" affair with Doug Hammond of Hollywood taking first, Johnny Van Dusen of Fairfax, second, Jeff Harvey of L. A. third and Duenz of Garfield, fourth, Si Wentworth of Hollywood fifth. The time was 51.3s.

Hollywood's crack relay team met a superior foe in Manual Arts due to Skinner's running as anchor man. Holding the lead to the last man, the Redskirts lost the race when Skinner overcame a three yard handicap to nip Hammond at the tape. The time was fast, 3m.0.7s.

Graves Wins Mile

Phil Graves added five points to Hollywood's total in the mile by leading Ned Jensen of Manual and "Blue" Mounday of Jeff to the tape. Graves had the fastest time this year of 4m.33s.
