

# SACRAMENTO DRAGONS ARE THIRD IN STATE TRACK AND FIELD FINALS AT GRIDLEY

GRIDLEY (Butte Co.), May 25.—But one California Interscholastic Federation record fell in the state meet held Saturday on the Gridley High School field. Jerry Lopes of the Placer Union High School set the time of 1:57.1 in the 880-yard run, the former record being 1:57.6 held by Satterfield of Manual Arts (1931) and Wood of Carpinteria (1935).

Muir Tech won the meet with 18 points, W. Wilson of Long Beach was second with 13, Sacramento third with 12; Gridley and Berkeley with 9 each tied for fourth. Santa Monica and Inglewood with 8 each tied for fifth; Glendale, sixth with 6 points; Long Beach, 5½ points, seventh; Placer, Palo Alto, California Deaf, Taft, Pittsburg, Tamalpais, Fillmore, 5 each; Montebello, Hollister, 4-1-3; Lodi, Claremont, Santa Maria, Stockton, Galt and Whittier, 4 points each; Paso Robles, Woodland, Fullerton, Alameda, Compton, Analay, Carpinteria, San Diego, 3 points each; Madera, 2½; Merced, Yuba City, Valencia, 2 each; Hayward, Lemoore, Fresno High, Excelsior, Edison Tech (Fresno), Shasta, 1 each; Westwood, 1-3.

Except for a 90 degree temperature the day proved ideal for the meet, the strong north wind of the day before abating especially for the occasion apparently. Two thousand spectators perspired and cheered the events.

Brady of Gridley, slow at the start, provided the thrills of the day in the 220-yard dash when he came to the front in the last few feet to take the race. All nine

points credited to Gridley were made by Brady.

# MUIR TECH WINS TITLE

*Terriers Score 18 Points to  
Trim Field; Lopez  
Breaks 880 Mark*

GRIDLEY, May 23. (AP)—One California Interscholastic Federation record was bettered in the organization's annual track and field meet at Gridley High School field today. Muir Tech won the meet with 18 points.

Lopes of Placer ran the 880-yard event in 1m. 57.1s., compared with the former mark of 1m. 57.6s. established by Satterfield of Manuel Arts in 1931 and equaled by Wood of Carpinteria in 1935.

There was no wind and the thermometer reached up to 90 in the shade. The 2000 spectators seemed nearly as much affected by the heat as the 125 participants.

## ANDERSON WINS

Mickey Anderson of Muir Tech won the 100-yard dash in the fast time of 9.7s. He was second in the 220. Sims of Santa Monica ran third in the furlong.

George Gray of Woodrow Wilson captured the 440 in 49.9s. Russell of Fillmore won the low hurdles in the time of 24.2s.

One of the thrills of the meet was provided by Farmer Brady of Gridley, who put on a finishing spurt to capture the 220-yard run. He placed second in the 100-yard dash, scoring all nine points taken by Gridley High School.

## WILSON SECOND

Woodrow Wilson High of Long Beach placed second to Muir Tech with 15 points. Sacramento was third with 12 points and Gridley and Berkeley tied for fourth with 9 points each.

Santa Monica and Inglewood each gathered 8 points, followed by Glendale, with 6 points; Long Beach, with 5½ points; Placer, Palo Alto, California Deaf School, Taft, Pittsburg, Tamalpais and Fillmore, with 5 points each; Hollister with 4½ points; Montebello, Lodi, Claremont, Santa Maria, Stockton, Galt and Whittier, with 4 points each; Paso Robles, Woodland, Fullerton, Alameda, Compton, Anny, Carpinteria and San Diego, with 3 points each; Madera, with 2½ points; Merced, Yuba City and Valencia, with 2
