

AZTECS TOP WHITTIER, REDLANDS IN MEET

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Raitt and Burdel Establish New Conference Marks in Three-Way Event

SAN DIEGO, April 23. (U.P.)—San Diego State College's track and field team scored an impressive win over Redlands and Whittier in a Southern California Conference triangular meet here today. The final scores were San Diego 85½, Redlands 39½, Whittier 38.

The three schools were closely watched insofar as first-place points were concerned, San Diego and Whittier having 5 each aside from the relay and Redlands trailing with 4. It was in the pace and show spots that San Diego strength was apparent.

NEW MARKS HUNG UP

Two individual conference records were established. Raitt tossed the shot 49ft. 8in. to score a win for Redlands in that event. In the two-mile run Burdel, San Diego, raced the distance in 9m. 38.2s. He bested the 9m. 47.2s. record set by Carter of Occidental in 1925.

Carter of Whittier proved his superiority over the sprinters from San Diego and Redlands to capture both the 100 and 220-yard dashes, being trailed across the tape by Koepsel of San Diego in each event.

REDLANDS FROSH WIN

In a preliminary meet the Redlands frosh won a dual meet from the Aztec frosh by a score of 66½ to 64½.
