* * * * Note: It is interesting to note the progress made in high school relay racing during the past 25 years or more — a circumstance which calls for proper credit to Southern California high school track and field coaches, for their progressive coaching methods, as well as to the athletes who have established new records as the seasons have passed.

In 1911, the Manual Arts High School Track and Field team won the Eight-Man One Mile Relay event with a time of 3:47.4.(City Meet.) By comparison, the Jefferson High School Eight-Man One-Mile Relay team established a new meet record in. the Los Angeles City Meet, last year, (1937) with a mark of 2:58.2. This record is considered the world high school mark for the event. The Jefferson High School team, coached by Harry Edelson, won the Los Angeles City Meet Eight-Man One-Mile Relay with a mark of 2:58.4, just 2/10 of a second short of the world record for the event. Twenty years, ago, in 1918, the winning time for the Eight-Man One-Mile Relay (City League Meet) was 3:11.8, 13.4 seconds slower than was made by the Jefferson High School team this year.
