Cathedral Nabs Second as Helwig Sets Record

SAN DIEGO, May 18. (U.P.)—John Helwig, Mt. Carmel High School shot putter, barely missed setting a new national interscholastic record in his specialty today as Redondo High's Skyhawks walked away with the 34th running of the annual C.I.F. track and field meet championships with a total of 24 1/2 points.

Helwig heaved the 12-pound iron ball 59ft., just an inch and a half short of the national high school record.

Redondo took three firsts in annexing the title for the first time, Bob Bacon, the low hurdles in 24.6s.; Jerry Witt, the half mile in 1m. 58.7s. and the 880-yard relay in 1m. 29.1s. Art Williams of Riverside, was the day's only double winner, copping both sprints. Cathedral High of Los Angeles, was second with 12 1/3 points and San Diego High next with 11. Summary:
