

San Mateo and Lincoln Score ⁴⁷ PAL Track Wins

Lincoln of San Jose and San Mateo demonstrated yesterday that again this year they will be the track powers in Peninsula Athletic League competition. Lincoln, in the first dual meet of the season, swamped Sequoia, 93-19, while San Mateo was dumping San Jose, 71-43. Palo Alto won the other meet of the day over Burlingame, 71-40.

Lincoln's Lions had a triple winner—Stan Hill, who won the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the broad jump.

Bad winds accounted for poor times at all three meets. The only outstanding mark posted at the Palo Alto-Burlingame meet was the work of Rudy Feldman who heaved the shot 47 feet 7 inches for a new meet record.

Lincoln scored 59½ points, Burlingame 11 and Sequoia, San Jose and Jefferson, 6 each.

Lax won the 100-yard dash in :102, the 220 in :22.9 and the high jump at 5 feet 8 inches. San Mateo won six first places to Lincoln's five, but failed to produce enough seconds, thirds and fourths.

Biggest upset was registered by John Kaufman of San Mateo who gave Tom Liston of Lincoln his first beating of the year in the mile. Kaufman trailed Liston to the last turn and then sprinted ahead to win in 4:37.5.

In the Class B division, San Jose scored 44 points, Burlingame 29, Sequoia 23, San Mateo 10, Lincoln 7, Palo Alto 5, South San Francisco 2 and Jefferson 1.

Class C honors went to Sequoia with 28 points while San Mateo and San Jose each got 17½ points, Lincoln 14½, Burlingame 7½, Jefferson 2 and Palo Alto 1.

San Mateo won the Class D with 30 points, Sequoia got 16, San Jose 7, Burlingame 6, Jefferson 3 and South San Francisco 3.
