Ags, State Split Titles

DAVIS, May 21.—(AP)—California Agricultural College retained its Far Western Conference track and field championship today.

The Aggies rolled up 76 points to San Francisco State's 54½. Chico State took third place with 30½. Southern Oregon had 3 points, while Humboldt State, with a small, inexperienced squad, went pointless.

Wilford Schlange of Cal Aggies picked up 13 points with firsts in the high jump and 120 yard high hurdles and second in 220 low hurdles. Sprinter John DeVries of San Francisco State notched 11¼ points by winning the 100 and 220 and being on the winning mile relay team.

SWIM TESTS.

Four records fell as the California Aggies won the swimming championship with 79 points. San Francisco State was second with 50½, followed by Chico State, 26½, and Humboldt State, 2.

The new marks were set in the 300 yard medley relay, won by the Aggie team in 3:24.2; 200 yard breaststroke, won by Scott of Aggies, 2:43.1; 400 yard free-style, won by Wade, San Francisco, 5:42.5; and 400 yard relay, Cal Aggies, 3:59.78.

San Francisco State won the tennis championship. Joe Woolson, San Francisco, defeated Paul Kuscel, Cal Aggies, 6-1, 6-1, 6-1, in the singles final. Warren Logan and Bob Downs, San Francisco, defeated Jack McGee and Hughes Davis, Chico State, 6-3, 5-7, 6-3, 10-8 in the doubles.

GOLF TO S. F.

San Francisco State's five man club won the conference golf title, with 841 strokes for 36 holes.

The five man SF State Club had a team score of 841 strokes for the thirty-six holes of play. California Aggies were second with 864 and Humboldt State third with 883. Chico State entries withdrew.

Low scoring honors went to Ray Moos of Cal Aggies with his 83-87—161.
