

WSC Nabs Track Title

SEATTLE, May 21. — (AP) — Lanky Fran Polsfoot skimmed the high hurdles in 14.4 seconds today to equal a 19-year-old record and lead Washington State College Cougars to a runaway triumph in the Northern Division Pacific Coast conference track meet.

The defending champion Cougars, blanked only in the pole vault, piled up 62 points to Oregon's 30½. Idaho, expected to finish last, was given a flying start when Warren Johanson scored an upset triumph in the mile, and the Vandals wound up in third place with 22 points. Washington had 19½, Oregon State, 16, and Montana, 15.

Polsfoot's cruise over the high sticks tied the division mark set in 1930 by Washington's Steve Anderson. A triumph in the low hurdles gave Polsfoot 10 points for the day and a tie for top honors with Oregon's Dave Henthorne, who won the 100 and 220-yard dashes.
