Solid first-place strength carried Coach Vic France's Glendale loover High Tornadoes to the CIF, Southern Section, track and eld title yesterday at Long Beach Wilson High with 24 points. Jumping Jack Davis paced the Hoover field title

triumph with two record-setting i hurdle victories, a strong second in the broad jump and a brilliant ì anchor leg on the victorious 880-yard relay team. His individual point total was 15¼, which was practically good enough to beat runner-up San Diego, The defending champion Hillers totaled 16 and were followed by Grossmont, 13½; Long Beach Poly, 12; Santa Monica, 11 1/3; and Glendale, 10½.

First event is at 1:30 p.m.

Davis is not only favored to win both hurdles but may cop the broad jump and anchor the Tornados' 880-yard relay team to victory. Only other Glendale Hoover athlete expected to place in an individual event is Jerry Borlin, and he figures to take no worse than second in the 440.

The evenly balanced field finds the defending champion San Diego club well represented in numbers but it'll have trouble retaining its crown. Grossmont, Long Beach Poly, Santa Monica, La Jolla and Cathedral will be up here vying for the runner-up spot.

Of course, an accident to the ring Davis would throw the lying the neet into a riotous scramble.

Davis established a new diviional record in both barrier events at last week's trials. He ped the high hurdles in 14.6s. to qual the standard and flashed ver the lows in 19.2s. to clip .5s

His 23ft. 912in off the record. broad jump was by far the bes recorded in the prelims, but Verle Sorgen of Riverside, who has leaped 24ft. 434in., was compet ing in the rain at San Diego and should win today.

#### Miller Paces Poly

Russ Miller will carry the brunt of the L.B. Poly contingent. He's the most consistent of a mediocre sprint crop and is also a 22ft. 6in broad jumper.

Don Hoefler of Fullerton looks like Borlin's toughest foe in the quarter. State Champion Wilbur Firestone of Compton shouldn's have much difficulty defending his 880 crown.

A flock of 4m. 32s. milers may put on the most spectacular race of the day. Herbie Morrison of Antelope Valley; Bob Simon, Po mona, and Larry Carter are all capable of breaking the tape.
