Davis Star of Hoover Triumph

Solid first-place strength carried Coach Vic France's Glendale Hoover High Tornadoes to the CIF, Southern Section, track and field title yesterday at Long Beach Wilson High with 24 points.

Jumping Jack Davis paced the triumph with two record-setting hurdle victories, a strong second in the broad jump and a brilliant anchor leg on the victorious 880-yard relay team. His individual point total was 15 1/4, which was practically good enough to beat runner-up San Diego. The defending champion Hillers totaled 16 and were followed by Grossmont, 13 1/2; Long Beach Poly, 12; Santa Monica, 11 1/3; and Glendale, 10 1/2.

Hurdles in 14.5s.

Davis started out his afternoon's campaign by lowering the meet high hurdle record with a beautifully run 14.5s. race. His mark trimmed a tenth of a second off the mark set by Keyser, Mt. Carmel, last year and equaled by Davis in the trials last week.

The well-built 6ft. 2in. lad then did his stint in the broad jump, and he catapulted himself 23ft. 7 1/2in., which was second only to a record leap by Riverside's Verle Sorgen. The latter hopped 24ft. 3 1/2in. to better the previous best, 24ft. 3/4in. by Willie Steele, San Diego, 1941.

Next was a little bit of low hurdling, an assignment he took care of in 19.2s. This tied the time he rambled in last week's prelim, a new record. But it could easily have been really sensational. Davis was away from the pack over the first hurdle but he missed his step on the second and the field racked up. Davis pulled away all over again and at the tape was four yards to the good.

Relay Battle

The piece de resistance came in the 880-yard relay. San Diego and Glendale Hoover were battling it out all the way and the Hillers' Hal Espy got a two-yard bulge on Davis on the anchor furlong.

Glendale Hoover Choice in CIF Spikefest Today

A fine facsimile of a one-man track team, Jack Davis, is expected to lead Glendale Hoover to the CIF, Southern Section, track and field championships this afternoon at Long Beach Wilson High.

First event is at 1:30 p.m.

Davis is not only favored to win both hurdles but may cop the broad jump and anchor the Tornados' 880-yard relay team to victory. Only other Glendale Hoover athlete expected to place in an individual event is Jerry Borlin, and he figures to take no worse than second in the 440.

The evenly balanced field finds the defending champion San Diego club well represented in numbers but it'll have trouble retaining its crown. Grossmont, Long Beach Poly, Santa Monica, La Jolla and Cathedral will be up there vying for the runner-up spot.

Of course, an accident to the flying Davis would throw the meet into a riotous scramble.

Davis established a new divisional record in both barrier events at last week's trials. He topped the high hurdles in 14.6s. to equal the standard and flashed over the lows in 19.2s. to clip .5s

off the record. His 23ft. 9½in broad jump was by far the best recorded in the prelims, but Verle Sorgen of Riverside, who has leaped 24ft. 4¼in., was competing in the rain at San Diego and should win today.

Miller Paces Poly

Russ Miller will carry the brunt of the L.B. Poly contingent. He's the most consistent of a mediocre sprint crop and is also a 22ft. 6in broad jumper.

Don Hoefler of Fullerton looks like Borlin's toughest foe in the quarter. State Champion Wilbur Firestone of Compton shouldn't have much difficulty defending his 880 crown.

A flock of 4m. 32s. millers may put on the most spectacular race of the day. Herbie Morrison of Antelope Valley; Bob Simon, Pomona, and Larry Carter are all capable of breaking the tape.

Hal Norris, Grossmont bulldog, is a cinch to win the shot-put. He has approached 57ft. Teammate Duane Pusey, a 13ft. performer, is the pole vault favorite and the high jump should be a battle among Bob Miller, Santa Monica and Tom DuHamel, Inglewood.
