

Lowell Leads In Field Test

Lowell's Indians underlined their threat to Washington's varsity track supremacy yesterday by qualifying nine field men for Saturday's All-City Meet.

The Eagles advanced five field men into the finals by way of the trials at Kezar Stadium.

Lowell now has seventeen starting place assured in the finals, while Washington and Poly have eleven apiece. However, seventeen Eagle runners will bid for starting berths in today's sprint and hurdle semifinals while the Indians have only seven in action today.

Surprise of the day was the failure of Balboa's Jack Fontaine to qualify in the shot put. The sole AAA performer to hit fifty feet this season, Fontaine could toss the twelve pound ball only forty-three feet yesterday after wearing himself out with muscle building exercises last week end.

Shot, discus and broad jump marks made in the trials hold up through the finals.

Six season bets were posted in the lightweight track trials. They are:
