

Piedmont Prep Shatters Two Track Records

Three records were broken unofficially, two of them by Piedmont hurdler Monte Upshaw, in the sub-section North Coast qualifying track trials on the Mt. Diablo high school track yesterday.

Upshaw ran :14.4 and :19.5 in hurdle trials, and the finals in :14.8 and :19.7 respectively for the highs and lows. James Jackson, Alameda sprinter, ran the 100 in :09.6 for the third unofficial record.

Piedmont Ace Sets 2 Marks

CONCORD, May 9.—Monte Upshaw of Piedmont turned in three victories and set unofficial records in the high and low hurdles today in the North Coast sub-section track and field meet.

Upshaw won the high hurdles, low hurdles and the broad jump. He ran the high hurdles in 14.4 and the low hurdles in 19.5, both in the heats.

Alameda's Jim Jackson won the 100 in 9.6, aided by a strong wind. Sophomore Dick Daily of Hayward turned in a six foot four and one quarter performance in the broad jump.

Alameda won the meet with 53 points. Richmond was second with 36 $\frac{3}{4}$ and El Cerrito finished third with 29. Complete results:
