Lincoln Quartet Run Distance in 8:25.07

Lincoln's two mile relay team shattered the Peninsula Athletic League record by 16 seconds to highlight the 12th Annual PAL relays held yesterday at Jefferson High in Daly City. The Lion team ran the distance in the time of 8:25.7.

As was expected, San Mateo captured its fourth straight relay championship. The Bearcats piled up 31 points to runner-up Capuchino's 18 points. Burlingame was third with 16 points. Willow Glen topped local entries with 11 points for fifth spot, while Lincoln was right behind in sixth place with 10 points.

Lee Cox's Lions swept far into the lead after the first lap of the two mile relay. Don Bowden opened up with a 2:04 for his two laps, while Charlie Ashby turned in a 2:08 to give the Lions a comfortable lead. Frank Wulftange and Rich Huerta topped things off with 2:06 each for their half mile stints.

Lincoln also grabbed another first in the B class medley as Marv Gross, Lion distance man, passed four opponents to grab the blue ribbon. Gross ran his part of the relay, the half mile, in the time of 2:08.5, an outstanding time for a lightweight runner.

Although they did not win a blue ribbon, Morry Goldner's Willow Glen Rams turned in a creditable all-around job. The Rams captured six fourth places, a third in the Class "A" 880 yard relay, and a second in the "B" Medley.

One other record was broken yesterday as San Mateo's shuttle hurdles quartet ran the barriers in 57.2 erasing Palo Alto's record of 57.4. The Bearcats also captured both varsity sprint relays by edging Burlingame by one-tenth of a second in both races.
