

Track Marks Voided

Upshaw Hurdles :18.9 With Wind In East Bay Meet

Piedmont's Monte Upshaw ran an unrecognized :19.9 low hurdles yesterday as competitors from three East Bay leagues advanced to next Saturday's North Coast Section track and field meet.

Three records were broken despite an announcement before the divisional meet at Richmond that times in straight races would be unacceptable for records because of the wind.

The new records: 1:30.1 by Alameda's 880-yard relay team; 143-4 discus throw by Richmond's John Danner; and 55-11 1/4 shot put by Acalanes' Ray Williamson.

Upshaw clocked the :18.9 in trials and took the finals in :19.1. He was beaten in a :14.8 high hurdles by Alameda's Joe Griffen.

Two other discus throws besides Danner's were over 140 feet. Jim Hart of Acalanes hit 142-2 and Arluther Lane of Alameda did 141-1 1/4.

Alameda's James Jackson, who won the 100 in :09.7, deliberately slowed down in the 220 so that teammate Willie Davis, Northern California's basketball player of the year, could win in :22.4.

Five B division records were broken and another tied. Glenn Lee of Pittsburg Junior High ran the 660 in 1:26.7; Encinal's Delbert Clayton ran the 330 in :37.7; Pittsburg's Dave Jet broad-jumped 20-4; Piedmont's Bud Crist put the shot 54-0 1/2 and Pittsburg's 440 relay team did :45.7. Amador's Bob Byrde equalled the pole vault mark of 10.9.

Placers in this meet join other Bay Area spikemen next Saturday at Berkeley in their final meet before the State Championships May 29.

Palo Alto Prep Runs Fast Mile

Roger (Bannister) Stephens of Palo Alto defeated some of the best of Northern California high school milers last night at Sunnyvale when he toured the four laps in 4:27.9, second best time in the State this year.

The mile highlighted the North Coast's division two meet.

Stephens, never out of second place, won over Wes Bond of Salinas, Bill Wilson of Santa Clara and Marv Gross of San Jose's Lincoln.

Eddie King led Salinas to the team championship by winning the 440 in a record :49.2, the 220 in :22.0 and anchoring the record setting 880 relay team which clocked 1:31.6.

Salinas scored 44 points to Burlingame's 32.

Don Bowden of San Jose's Lincoln, national half-mile champion, failed to better last week's time of 1:53.2 but recorded a 1:54.8, good enough for a new meet record.

In other record performances Rink Babka of Palo Alto tossed the discus 140-6 1/2 and Ron Frizzell of Willow Glen pole-vaulted 12-6 1/4.

Class B records set were Jim Rector's 3:18.3 in the 1320 for Jefferson, John Nune's :36.5 in the 330 for Santa Clara and Bud Hamblin's discus toss of 130-3 for Watsonville. Watsonville won the Class B title.
