

Bucs Shade James Lick By 1-Point

Sutterfield's Win In Vault Decides Meet

Bill Sutterfield, Campbell pole vaulter, sailed over the bar at 11 ft. 9 in. to give the Bucs a slim one point 73-72 victory over a fighting James Lick team in last night's Santa Clara Valley Athletic League track finals held on the Fremont High oval.

Sutterfield's victory in the vault climaxed a tremendous comeback by Junior Morgan's troops. With three events left to go Lick held a huge 23-point lead. However, to start the ball rolling, Campbell's relay team scored an upset victory over the Comets, who were minus Ed Brewer. The Bucs set a new record of 1:32.7. Brewer hurt his left leg after his victory in the low hurdles, and the favored Lick quartet had to settle for third spot behind Los Gatos.

Campbell was still down 18 points, but Olon Forrest captured the high jump with a leap of 5 ft. 8½ in. to set the stage for Sutterfield's crucial vault. The Campbell ace cleared 11 ft. 9 in. on his first attempt but missed in his try to break the meet's record of 12 ft. 1 in.

Besides the relay four new SCVAL records were set by the competing preps. Brewer skimmed over the high hurdles to break the tape in 15.2 and eclipse Campbell's Howard Kaeding's three-year-old mark. Brewer became a double winner by edging Campbell's Roy Cureton in the low barriers with a clocking of 20.9. Cureton had set a new record of 20.4 in Tuesday's trials.

Mountain View's Don Richardson lowered his own 880 mark by two-tenths of a second by posting a time of 2:01.6. Jim Guidotti flipped the shot put 53 ft. 7½ in. to break his own record set in the trials, and Los Gatos' Cline Armstrong got off a 138 ft. 6 in. discus toss for the final new record.

James Lick's John Aguiar captured both sprints for the second year in a row with times of 10.3 and 22.5. Gary Antes ran the best race of his life to gain a victory in the mile run over Campbell's Ken Beth. Antes broke the tape in 4:35.9.

Clarence Nunes sparked Santa Clara to a victory in the B class. Nunes set three new records with times of 37.3 and 15.2 for the 330 and 150-yard dashes and put the shot 55 ft. 9 in. The Santa Clara flash also anchored the winning Panther relay team to a new mark of 44.9, which ties the North Coast record. Campbell won the C class with 51½ points, while Fremont won class D by totaling 55½ markers.
