Salinas Preps Win North Coast Sectional Track

SALINAS, May 19 — The Salinas High track team scored 31 points to edge Watsonville, 27, in the North Coast Section Two meet today.

Dick Brown, Lincoln of San Jose, beat King City's Tom Pettit in a :09.8 hundred and Pettit turned the tables on Brown in a :21.8 furlong. Palo Alto's Ron Larrieu took the mile in 4:27.6 and Jim Matejka, Sequoia, pole vaulted 13-3 $\frac{3}{4}$ for victory.

Carlmont's Lee Valentine won the high and low hurdles to take the only double triumph.

North Coast To Salinas

SALINAS, May 19.—Scoring an unexpected win in the 880 relay, the Salinas High Cowboys came from behind here today to capture the North Coast Section Division II track and field championships.

The cowboys' victory in the final event allowed them to overtake another coast counties school, Watsonville. Salinas finished with 31 points, the Wildcats scored 27-1/6.

Four meet records went down the drain as the shot put, mile, 220 and pole vault marks were shattered.

Palo Alto's fine distance runner, Ron Larrieu, turned in an excellent 4:27.6 in the mile. His previous best for the year was 4:29.2.

Salinas also won the lightweight meet with ease as it scored 75 points to its nearest competitors' 24.
