

Menlo School captures BCAL track crown

Menlo School broke two records while claiming the Bay Counties Athletic League track and field championship last Saturday at the Menlo College field.

Skip Spence shattered the high jump record with a leap of 6-4 and the Acorns' 880-yard relay team of Kim Tearman, Dick Lawson, Jim Moore and Spence set a new mark, 1:34.2.

Spence also won the 100-yard dash, reeling off a time of 10.2.
