

Menlo-Atherton nabs NCS track crown

Powered by the strength in the muscular right arms of Bob Atkinson and Tom Strong, Menlo-Atherton High School added the North Coast Section Group II title to its list of 1957 track and field honors. The Bears scored 34 $\frac{3}{4}$ points to outdistance the huge field.

Atkinson pushed the shot 54-8, more than a foot farther than runner-up Pete Cave of Watsonville. The long-awaited battle between Atkinson and Campbell's mighty Mike Profit never happened. Profit sat out the meet with an injury but was awarded a spot in next week's NCS finals at Berkeley.

STRONG, THE hottest discus thrower in California in recent weeks, whirled the college weight platter 147-6 $\frac{1}{2}$ to edge Al Naslund of Salinas. More points went on the Bear scorecard when Atkinson took a fifth in the discus and Strong garnered the same spot in the shot.

Cubberley, with a two-man entry, took seventh place in the meet. Dave Kilbourne and Ernie Stevenson, each going in two events, comprised the Cougar squad.

Kilbourne took second in the high hurdles after a stirring duel with Santa Clara's Larry Guilford. Kilbourne got three more points in the 440 while suffering his first losses of the year.

He led until the last 20 yards in the 440 when he was nipped by Doug Robertson of Los Gatos. Robertson had the inside lane and it made the difference in the stretch.

STEVENSON GOT off to a great start in the 220 and led by three yards at the half way point. He was nipped at the tape by Jim Cudworth of Sequoia.

Palo Alto had its moment of glory in the Class B 1320. John Northway built up such a lead that not even fast finishing teammate Gerge Linn could catch him.
