

Farmer Stars In All-Comers

BURLINGAME — High schooler Dixon Farmer from Miramonte of Orinda prepared for the Pacific Athletic Assn. decathlon championships on Aug. 22-23 by winning three events and placing second twice in the All-Comers track and field meet here Saturday.

Farmer, who competed in the national AAU decathlon this year, won the 220, broad jump and hop-step-jump and was runnerup to San Josean Kent Herkenrath in the 100 and low hurdles. Farmer's broad jump mark of 23-ft., 2½-in., his all-time best, was the outstanding individual mark of the day.
