## RCTC FILLS A NEED

One of the major goals of the Northern California Track and Field Association has been to promote the sport during the summer months when, as proven by the Europeans, conditions are best for track.

Last year, in its first year as an organization, the NCT&FA, along with the Redwood City Recreation Department, sponsored the Northern California Invitational June 15 at Sequoia High School.

With the college and university trackmen engaged in NCAA competition in Texas that weekend, the NCI provided a chance for club, junior college and college frosh trackmen to prepare for the National AAU meet the following weekend.

This year, the NCT&FA felt a greater need would be filled by putting on its meet July 19th as the first major summer meet to be held on an annual basis in this country.

Coinciding with a three-day downtown promotion, 'Sidewalk Days,' held by the Merchants of Redwood City, the meet is co-sponsored by the Redwood City Chamber of Commerce, as well as the NCT&FA and the Recreation Department.

Due to the tie-in with the city, it was decided to change the meet's name to Redwood City Track Carnival.

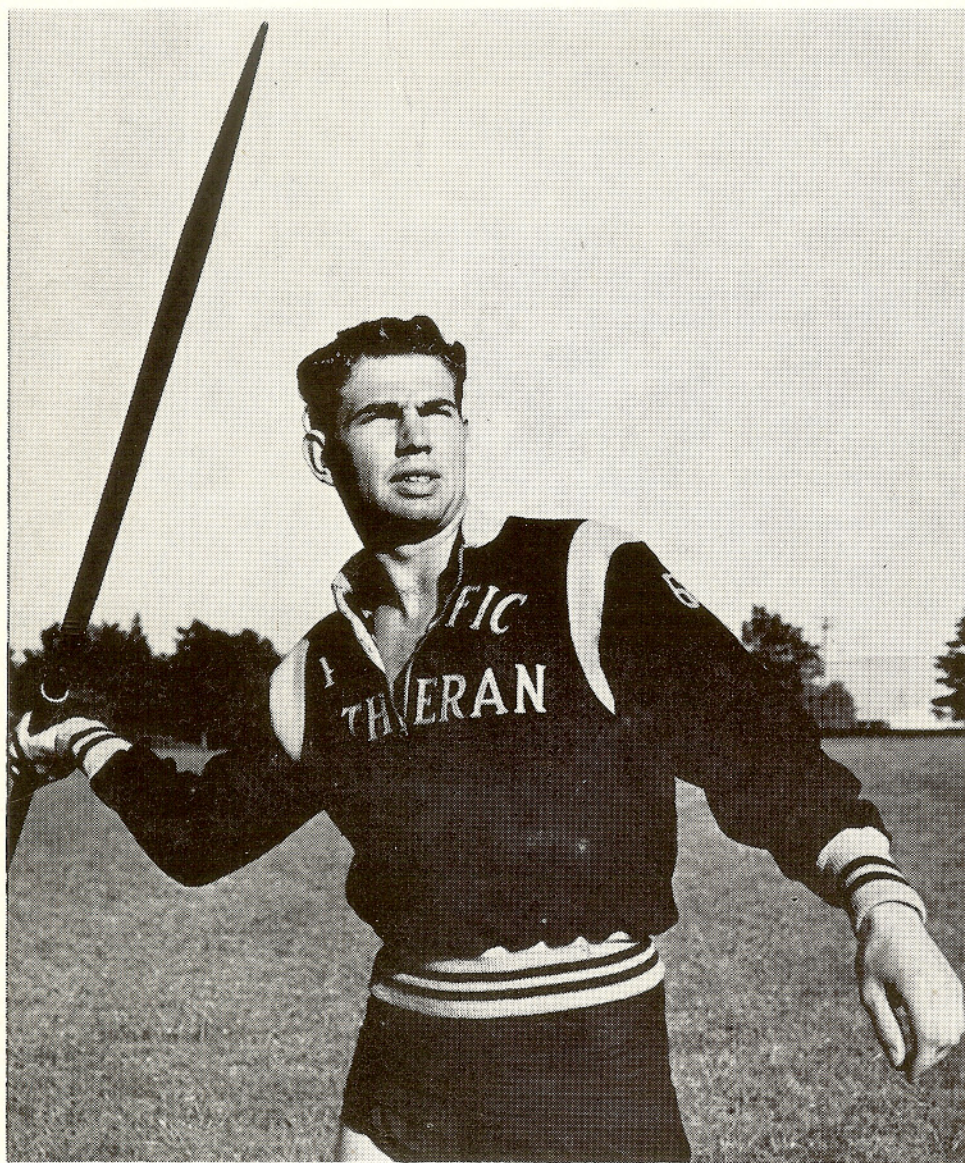

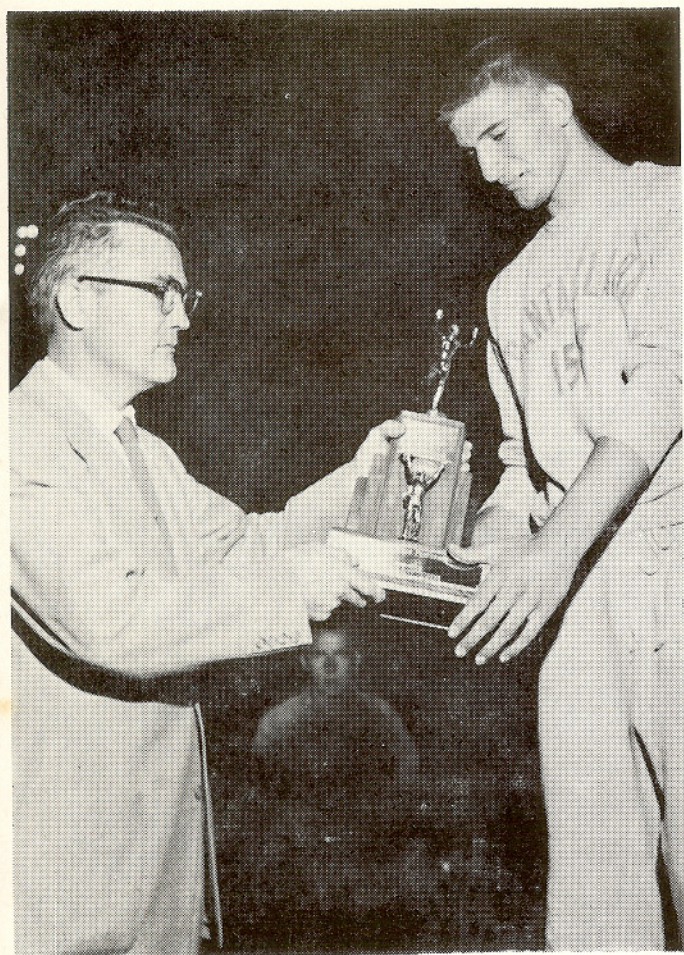

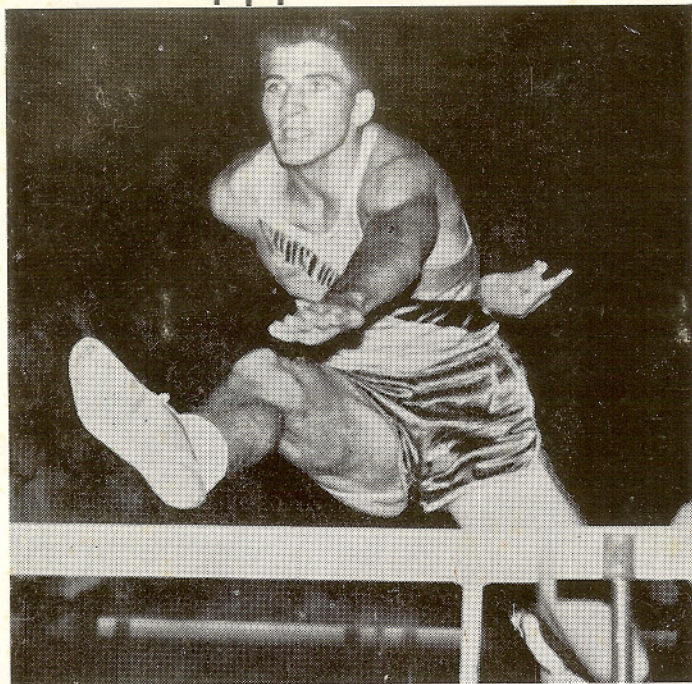
