4th at King City

Palo Alto High School scored 18½ points to place fourth in the annual King City relay meet Saturday.

The Vikes took three seconds and four thirds in the meet. Host King City won with 29½ points, two more than runner-up Salinas. Carmel finished third with 24 points.

JOHN PASTINIEKS of Palo Alto took second in the broad jump and tied for third in the high jump. Teammate Norm Elaison also tied for third in the high jump.

George Linn, Vike half miler was edged out in that event. The winning time, by Bruce Logan of Salinas, was 2:00.6, two seconds slower than Linn has run this season.

Don Beal of Palo Alto took second in the pole vault and Bill Brown was second to Santa Clara's Larry Guilford in the high hurdles. Brown was third in the low hurdles.

DOUG SCHOENWETTER, Fremont High School's fine weight man, won the discus and shot-put. His distances were 129-6 and 50-3¾.

Mike Chilton of Palo Alto won the Class B 660-yard run in 1:29. Tom Fegundes of Sunnyvale won the B 330-yard run in 37.5.

KING CITY—Coach Roland Dickie's host Mustang cindermen captured their own King City Invitational Saturday, taking advantage of excellent weather at the War Memorial field. The Mustangs topped second place Salinas by two points 29½-27½ but the King City team didn't compete in the final event, the 880 relay, where the Cowboys picked up four points.

Carmel was third with 24 points, Palo Alto was fourth with 18½ points and fifth was Fremont with 13 points. Madera had 12¼, San Luis Obispo, 12 Santa Clara, 12; Santa Maria, 11¼; Monterey, 10½; Bellarmine, 8; Sunnyvale, 3½; Atascadero, 2; Paso Robles, 3; Arroyo Grande, 2; Santa Cruz, 2; Watsonville, 1½; Morgan Hill, 1; Gonzales, 0; Hollister, 0; Mountain View, 0; and San Lorenzo Valley, 0.

Larry Homen took the trophy donated by Cliff Hall for the King City high point man. He placed first in the 100 yard dash with a time of 10.3 and a second in the 220 yard dash giving him a total of nine points. He was also awarded a watch, donated by James Pettitt, for winning the 100 yard dash.

Pat Curran took a first place for King City in the mile with a time of 4:38.9. Curran came up this year from the lightweight 1320, which he won at the Invitational last year. He ran his best time in the meet Saturday and also set a new school record. The old one stood at 4:40.5.

Len Breschini of Salinas took first in the 440 with a time of 50.2. His time tied the record made in the 1927 by Les Hables of King City and tied by King City's Frank Baker in 1957.

King City's Bill Macklin tied for first place in the high jump with Clint Lykins of Monterey with 5'7½". This was the best Macklin has ever jumped.

In the 180 low hurdles John Bigger of Madera took first

place with a time of 20.1 and beat the old record of 20.5 set by Bruce Philpott of Salinas in 1956.

Ted Smith of Carmel also broke two Invitational records. He took first in the pole vault with 12'5". The previous record had been set at 12'2" by Ivan Hartsell of Salinas in 1956. He took first and broke the record in the broad jump with a jump of 22'2¼". The record had stood at 21'1½", set by Don McDowell, of Watsonville in 1956.

In the lightweight division Santa Clara and Watsonville tied for first with 32½ points, and Madera came in second with 31½ points. Salinas had 28, Santa Maria, 22½; Hollister, 9; Palo Alto, 8; Sunnyvale, 7; King City, 5; Monterey, 4; Gonzales, 4; Fremont, 3; Atascadero, 2½; Bellarmine, 2; Mountain View, 2; San Luis Obispo, 1; Santa Cruz, ½; Arroyo Grande, 0; Carmel, 0; Morgan Hill, 0; Paso Robles, 0; and San Lorenzo Valley, 0.

Adrian Avila of King City took first place in the 1320 with a time of 3.25 and set a new Invitational record. The old one set by Gilbert Hernandez of Salinas in 1956 stood at 3:28.1. Tim Dovali of Santa Maria bettered the old record in the shot put of 54'11" set by Derroyl Wynn of Fremont in 1957. He had a put of 56'9¼".

Tom Fagundes of Sunnyvale was awarded a trophy donated by Vince Whitney for the winner of the 330 yard dash. His time was 37.5. Wilbert Holly of Madera with 5'10" in the high jump set a

new record. The old one had been set at 5'9½" by Ky Miyamoto of Monterey in 1933. Santa Clara's relay team tied the 452 record set by Salinas in 1956 and tied again by Salinas in 1957.
