M E E T C O M M E N T A R Y

Only one team race--in the C Division--looms in tonight's Sequoia District track meet. Otherwise, it looks like Menlo-Atherton all the way.

But some first-rate action is promised while the Bears are racking up the points in varsity and B divisions. Varsity meet records are threatened in the 440, 180 low hurdles, 220 yard dash, broad jump and high jump. Standards are almost sure to go in the 100 yard dash, and the 880 yard relay.

Some outstanding athletes are on display, too. M-A's Bob Kennedy is one of the most versatile trackmen in the region; Carlmont's Bob Stevens, a junior, has bettered 10 seconds in the 100; and the Scots' Chris Jessen, also a junior, is one of Northern California's top half-dozen shot putters. The Menlo-Atherton relay team is a threat for regional honors, too.

Sequoia has two Class B performers who already have proven themselves the best in school history. Discus thrower John McGregor and distance runner Larry Shade are on the way toward becoming all-time greats.

M-A's Class B hurdlers, Jerry Varty and John Clark, are the best any participating school has ever had. And the B sprints are blessed with three or four top-drawer contestants.

The race between M-A and Sequoia in the C Division will be a thriller all the way.

But win or lose, in high school sports the competition's the thing. And nearly 200 athletes will provide plenty of that here this evening.

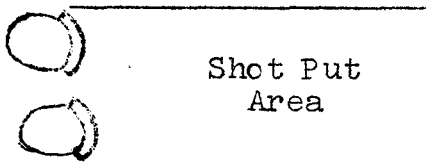
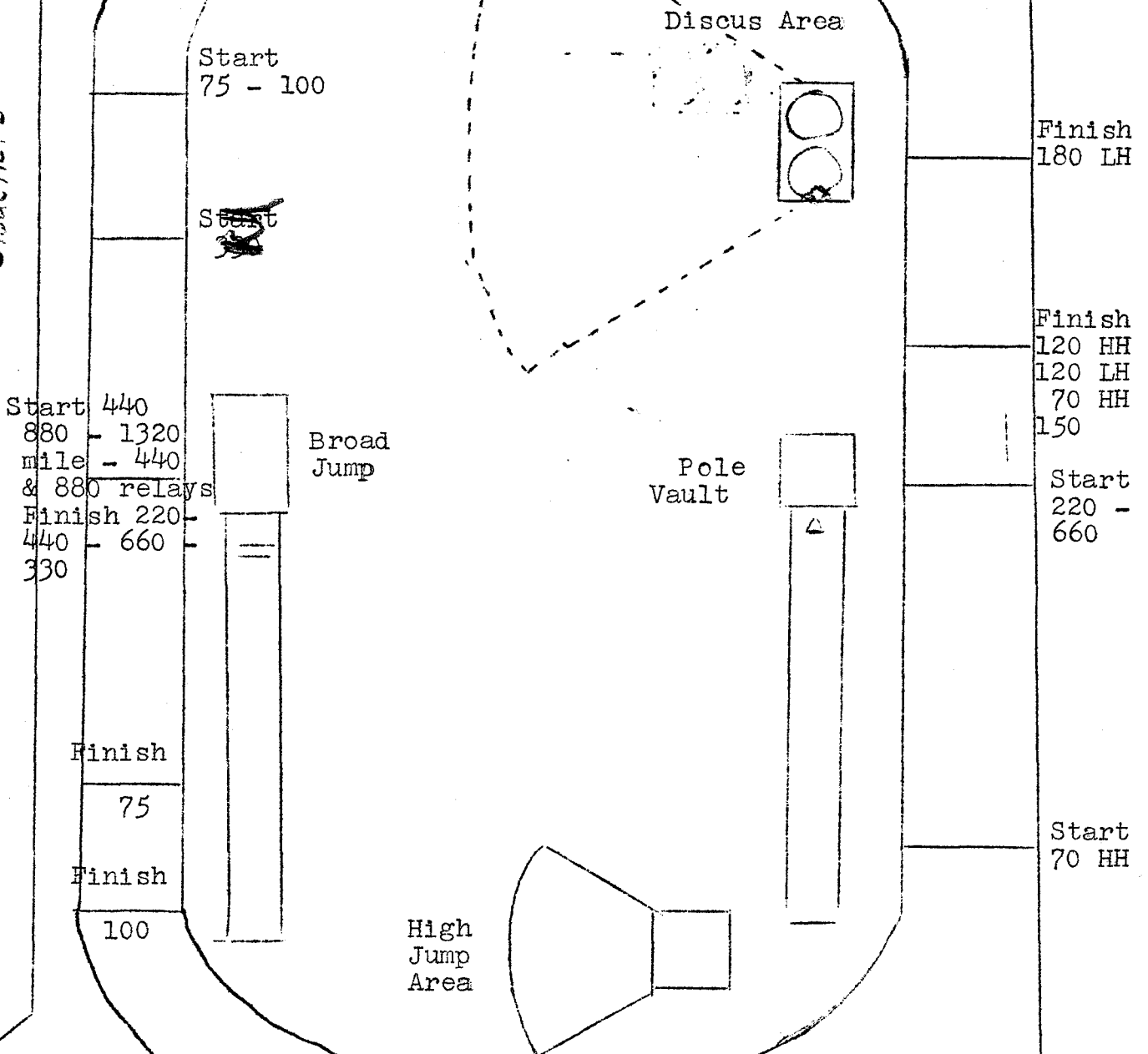
