

Turlock Takes Section Spike Title

Turlock High School completed its sweep of track and field honors yesterday by winning its first SacJoaquin sectional varsity title in history yesterday in Sacramento.

Coach Joe Debely's Bulldogs totaled 26½ points, 12½

more than the nearest opponent; C. K. McClatchy. It was Turlock's first north sectional championship since 1935. The Bulldogs won the dual meet, conference and sub sectional titles.

Whether Turlock will com-

pete in the California Relays or go to the state meet in Los Angeles May 31st has not been decided. The Bulldogs qualified sprinter Ron Osborne, sprinter-hurdler Jim Garner and pole vaulter Jim Harlan in individual events plus a relay team.

Debely indicated his team might forego the state meet since he figures Turlock can grab off the Modesto relays crown.

Take Third

Oakdale finished third in the A race yesterday only one third point ahead of Livingston. The Mustangs made 11½. Second place McClatchy had 14. Escalon picked up 5, Sonora 4, Ceres 3½, Downey 3½ and Modesto 2.

Stanislaus district champions included Oakdale's Tom Plante with 10.1 in the 100 and 21.9 in the 220, and Escalon's Wendell Eliason.

The only varsity mark to fall was in the 440 as Edison's George Cohen raced to a 48.7 clocking, compared to the old 49.2 standard.

The two top finishers in the individual varsity events qualified for the state meet.

There is no B and C competition in the state event.
