Top Marks Feature South Sectional Test

TURLOCK — Some of the best performances of the season—and of entire Northern California—were turned in Saturday in the subsectional track meet under a blazing Turlock sun. It took a superb effort to win each event—and some of them were more than superb.

For instance:

1. A 23-5 in the broad jump by Patterson's Eddie Richardson, who excelled by more than a foot his previous high of the year.

2. A blistering 1:29.6 by Turlock High School's star-studded relay team.

3. A 1:57.2 half mile by another Richardson — John of Sonora, whose previous best was 1:58.6.

Others Outstanding

The broad jump and relay marks perhaps were the most stunning. Scarcely more than

the 120 high hurdles and won the 180 lows in 19.7.

a week before, in the Central California Conference qualifying meet, Eddie Rash of Turlock had won the broad jump as he leaped 22-10 1/4 to top by just a fourth of an inch the previous Northern California high. Richardson had not come within even six inches of that.

And Edison, on that occasion, had beaten Turlock.

Continue Dash Feud

Jim Garner of Turlock and Tom Plante of Oakdale continued their sizzling rivalry in the 100 with Garner winning this time by a half step at 9.9. Plante had won by a shade in the CCC meet and both had done 9.8 earlier this season.

The marks turned in in the B class were good enough to win many varsity dual meets in normal years. Jackson's Rule did 10.1 in the 100, Snyder of Livingston 21-3 in the broad jump, Whitney of Dow-
