5 Norcal Spike Bests Registered

Willie Davis, Roosevelt of Los Angeles, and Paul Stuber, Bellflower, turned in impressive field event marks to feature California high school track and field activity last week.

Davis sailed 25-ft., 3-in. in the broad jump Friday while Stuber, a 15-year-old junior, high jumped 6-ft., 8 1/4-in. Saturday.

Davis, who divides athletic talents between baseball and track, bettered his previous best by over a foot and became the third leading broad jumper on the all-time list.

Only three high schoolers, all from California, had jumped over the 25 ft. mark previously. The national record holder is Monte Upshaw, Piedmont, who did 25 ft. 4 1/4 in. in 1954.

Stuber's feat also placed him third on the all-time prep list in the high jump and made him the best-ever junior in his specialty. He took the national lead from another junior, Joe Faust of Culver City, who had gone 6-ft., 7 1/2-in.

Five Northern California bests were registered last week, two of them in the

South Peninsula Athletic League finals here. Terry Baker, Menlo-Atherton, did 23 ft. 3 in. in the broad jump, a Peninsula record and George Linn, Palo Alto junior, ran the mile in 4:26.0, best ever by a Peninsula junior.

Other North state bests went to Dixon Farmer, Miramonte of Orinda, :19.3 in low hurdles; Rich Klier, Castlemont of Oakland, 1:58.0 in 880, and Bill Hook, Ukiah, 152 ft. 1 1/4 in. with college weight discus.
