

Long Leads USC to Track Title

SEATTLE, May 28 (AP)—One of Dallas Long's run-of-the-mill shotputs—a mere 61 feet 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches—won the event for him today and the rest of his USC teammates found victory an easy assignment in the Big Five track and field meet.

The favored Trojans stacked up 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ points in this inaugural meet of the Athletic Association of Western Universities (Big Five). UCLA was second with 51, California scored 46 $\frac{1}{2}$, Washington 32 $\frac{1}{2}$, Stanford 26 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Ernie Cunliffe of Stanford, regarded as the West Coast's leading half-miler, was nipped at the tape by Jerry Siebert of California. Both were timed at 1:49, nearly two seconds slower than Cunliffe's best.

Cunliffe did not enter the mile, which he has run in 4:00.4, leaving the role of favorite to Bob Holland of UCLA. But Holland had to finish with a burst of speed to overtake Jack Larson of Washington and win in 4:08.8.
