

TROJAN DYNASTY

The USC track and field team you will see today is one of the greatest ever assembled under collegiate colors, yet this is in reality just another representative Trojan team.

The men of Troy have not lost a collegiate meet since California whipped them in 1943 . . . 17 years and 60 meets ago; the Trojans have not lost a team meet; collegiate or otherwise, since the Los Angeles Athletic Club whipped them 86 meets ago in 1948. USC hasn't lost a peacetime collegiate meet in 123 times since Stanford beat them in 1933.

Quite a record indeed, but it merely fits into the Southern California tradition. Since 1900 the Trojans have won 211 dual meets, lost 62 and tied three. They have won 20 of the 30 NCAA meets they have entered, and finished second on five other occasions.

Their undergraduates and graduates have had their hands in 48 world records throughout the years, and right now share in two world marks: the 100-yard dash and the 120-yard high hurdles; and own two more outright: the 110-meter high hurdles and the shot put. They own or share in five collegiate records, too.

USC men have won 13 individual Olympic championships and 44 Trojans have competed in the Olympic games track and field competition.

USC has won a total of 56 individual NCAA championships and 119 individual Pacific Coast Conference titles. USC was defeated only once in PCC championship meets from 1928 through 1959.

Five Trojans have run the 100 in :09.5 or better; 10 have broken :21 flat in the 220; five have bettered :47 flat in the 440; five have run better than 1:51 flat in the 880; eight have bettered 4:10 in the mile; two USC men, both holders at one time of the Collegiate record, have bettered nine minutes for two miles; two Trojans have cracked :14 flat in the high hurdles; three have gone below :23 flat in the low hurdles; five USC men have leaped better than 25 feet in the broad jump; 11 have vaulted better than 14'6"; two of their high jumpers have cleared 6'11", and on a number of occasions, too; three USC men have put the shot better than 63 feet; and two have thrown the javelin better than 250 feet, with three others topping the 230-foot mark.

We are impressed!!!
