JEFF TOPS CITY QUALIFIERS AS WIND HAMPERS RECORDS

A 5 m.p.h. headwind and East Los Angeles College's slow track yesterday prevented city spikers from making an assault on the record books as Jefferson's Southern League titlists topped the field in the 1960 City Prelims.

Although losing the services of injured Wayne Curl, city low hurdle leader at 19.0, the well-balanced Democrats nosed out Jordan (10), and Manual Arts (9) with 12 qualifiers.

Jordan's state sprint champ Hubie Watson didn't near his 9.5 and 20.7 best dash marks, but ran away from his heat rivals in 9.8 and 21.7 clockings.

Thrilling Duel

Milers Dick Doherty (San Pedro) and Mickey McBain (Los Angeles) tied up in a thrilling duel, Doherty edging McBain by inches in 4:27.0. Both Doherty's and McBain's (4:27.1) times were city bests.

Paul Turnquist of North Hollywood shook off a leg injury that had sidelined him for two weeks and sped to a 1:56.8 half mile. Garfield's Gene Bruno (1:55.8) was upset in another close 880 heat by Les Severe (Washington) and Don Nichols (San Pedro) in a 1:57.1 race.

With Fremont's Donald Cook (48.3) out of the meet, Jeff's James Tyrone took over the favorite's role in the city quarter mile by

turning in a 48.8 effort. Other 440 heats were won by Poly's Joe Guth (49.9) and Manual Arts' Leroy Hurte (49.6).

Cleveland's Dave Bailey was an exception to the day's generally slow hurdle marks with a 14.5 win in the highs. Curl, who pulled a left leg muscle earlier in the week in practice, reinjured it at the start of his lows heat and San Fernando's Mike Tisdale went on to win the race at 20.0 into the wind.

Field Qualifiers

Franklin's consistent shot-putter Al Jacobs topped field event qualifying by tossing the shot 53ft. 6 1/4 in., a foot below his best. Jim Honberger of Van Nuys paced broad jump qualifying with a 22ft. 9 1/2 in. leap, as marks in that event were below par.

Jefferson and Jordan set the stage for a tight relay race next week by winning their heats in 2:58.9. Curl's absence hurt Jeff's city-leading (2:57.4) relay team.
