

SM Gals Win At Oakland

In their last meet before the National championships, the San Mateo Girls' Athletic team flashed their winning forms before the best in the West Saturday at Oakland's Western U. S. Women's Open track and field meet.

Pat Daniels of San Mateo was involved in three record performances. She set marks in the 800 meter race with a fine finish to nip Judy Shapiro of Los Angeles and in the running broad jump, topping her own Western Women's record with a leap of 17 feet 3¼ inches.
