

7 Wildcats advance to NCS II track meet

Seven Los Gatos High School trackmen, including three WSCVAL champions, qualified for the North Coast Section II track and field meet Saturday at Westmoor High School in Daly City by placing in the first three finishes Friday in the WSCVAL finals at Camden.

The three Los Gatos championships were produced by:

1. Dick Harding, varsity 180 yard low hurdles, 19.7.
2. Bruce Pearson, B 660, 1:25.3, a new record.
3. Walt Lochner, B high jump, 5-9½.

Others who qualified for the NCS II meet are John Kuoppamaki who tied for second in the pole vault with a personal best of 11 ft. 9 in.; Robin Wainwright, Los Gatos' most pleasant surprise in an unofficial 2:02.2 second place in the 880; Bob Moore and Gil Mesa, who teamed with Wainwright and Harding for a second place in the 880 relay, and Harding who also made it with a close second in the 120 high hurdles and Lochner with a second place in the hop step and jump.

Los Altos had no strain winning its third straight WSCVAL crown with 64½ points, almost double its nearest competitor; Fremont took the B title with 50 points, edging Camden and Los Altos, tied with 64½, and Mountain View won the C and D crowns.

Tim Bradley scored all Los Gatos C points, taking a second in the 330 by inches behind Del Mar's Reed in new record time of 38.5 and finishing third in the broad jump with a leap of 19-10. Bradley lost on two leaps in the broad jump while he was competing in the 75 and 330 and judges were not recalled to the pit.

Harding was edged by a tenth of a second in the high to Mountain View's long-legged junior, Phil Arnaudo, who set a new mark of 14.8. Later Harding took the low decider in 19.7, one-tenth off the new WSCVAL mark he set in the trials.

Out of 10 records broken in the three divisions, Pearson's

1:25.3 clocking for the B 660 may be the most drastic reduction. The old mark of 1:27.4 was set last year by Larson of Santa Clara when Pearson, coming back from a late season illness, fell near the finish.

While Los Altos' Robin Roble was running by himself to an easy win in the 880 in 1:54.4, Wainwright supplied the big action of the event, coming from near last to second place ahead of Miller of Los Altos by an eyelash.

A former 440 entry, Wainwright indicated he may go under two minutes this week. Later in the relay, he ran a strong second leg, pulling the Cats into second place, a position Harding and Mesa maintained in an unofficial clocking of 1:32.6, the best in Los Gatos history.

Coch Fred Niemann clocked Wainwright in 2:02 and other clocks had the third place Miller in 1:59.3 which may mean the Los Gatos was under two minutes.

Kuoppamaki stayed in contention for the pole vault title until Jim McCracken of Los Altos cleared 12 feet to wind up the field events for the evening. Blair Hull tied for

fifth in the pole vault and Ted Matthies was fifth in the high jump to account for Los Gatos scoring.

Saratoga's one point in the C meet came on Julio Gonzales' fifth in the 75 yard dash and the Falcons' three points in the D meet were the product of Carlos Simpson's fourth in the 100 and fifth in the 50.

Vossbrinck, Kibby advance to NCS tennis

Los Gatos senior doubles Doug Vossbrinck and Byron Kibby will represent the WSCVAL Saturday in the NCS II tennis championships at Stanford University while Del Mar's Richard Gugat will be the singles representative for the third straight year.

The Wildcat combination won the trip Saturday at Cupertino by taking the WSCVAL crown by defeating Langdon Winslow and Bill Johnson of Camden, 6-0, 6-3. It was the third straight-set victory of the tournament for Vossbrinck and Kibby who earlier

in the day eliminated Dave Young and Kell Moss of Los Altos, 6-1, 6-0.

Gugat, who won the title twice previously while at Camden, took the title with a 6-2, 6-1 victory over John Oldemeyer of Los Altos.

Both singles finalists received stiff tests from West Valley entries. Los Gatos' Chet Creider jumped to a 5-2 lead over Gugat before bowing, 7-5, 6-1, and Saratoga's sophomore singles ace Mike Hawkes extended Oldemeyer, 6-1, 6-8, 6-4.
