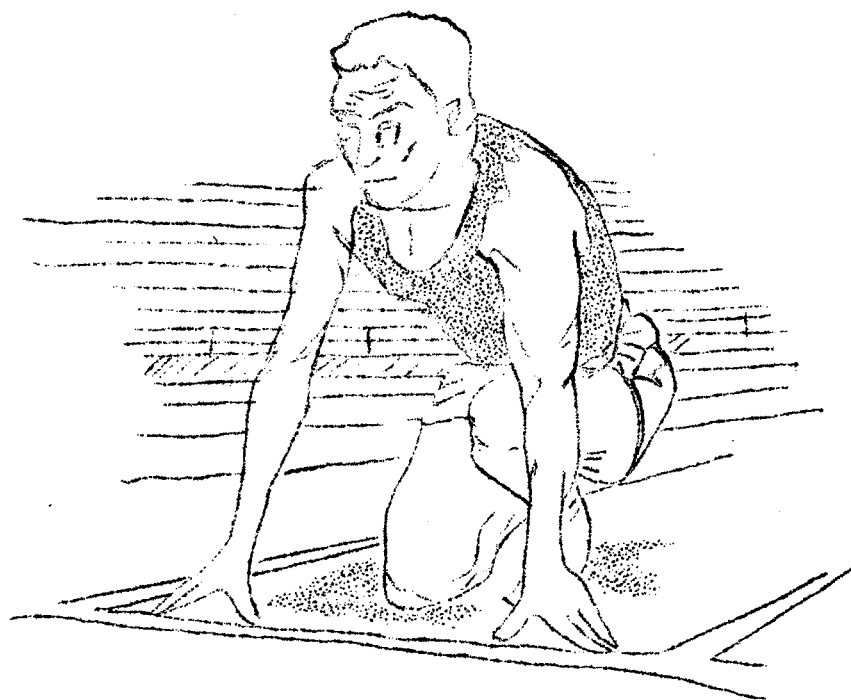

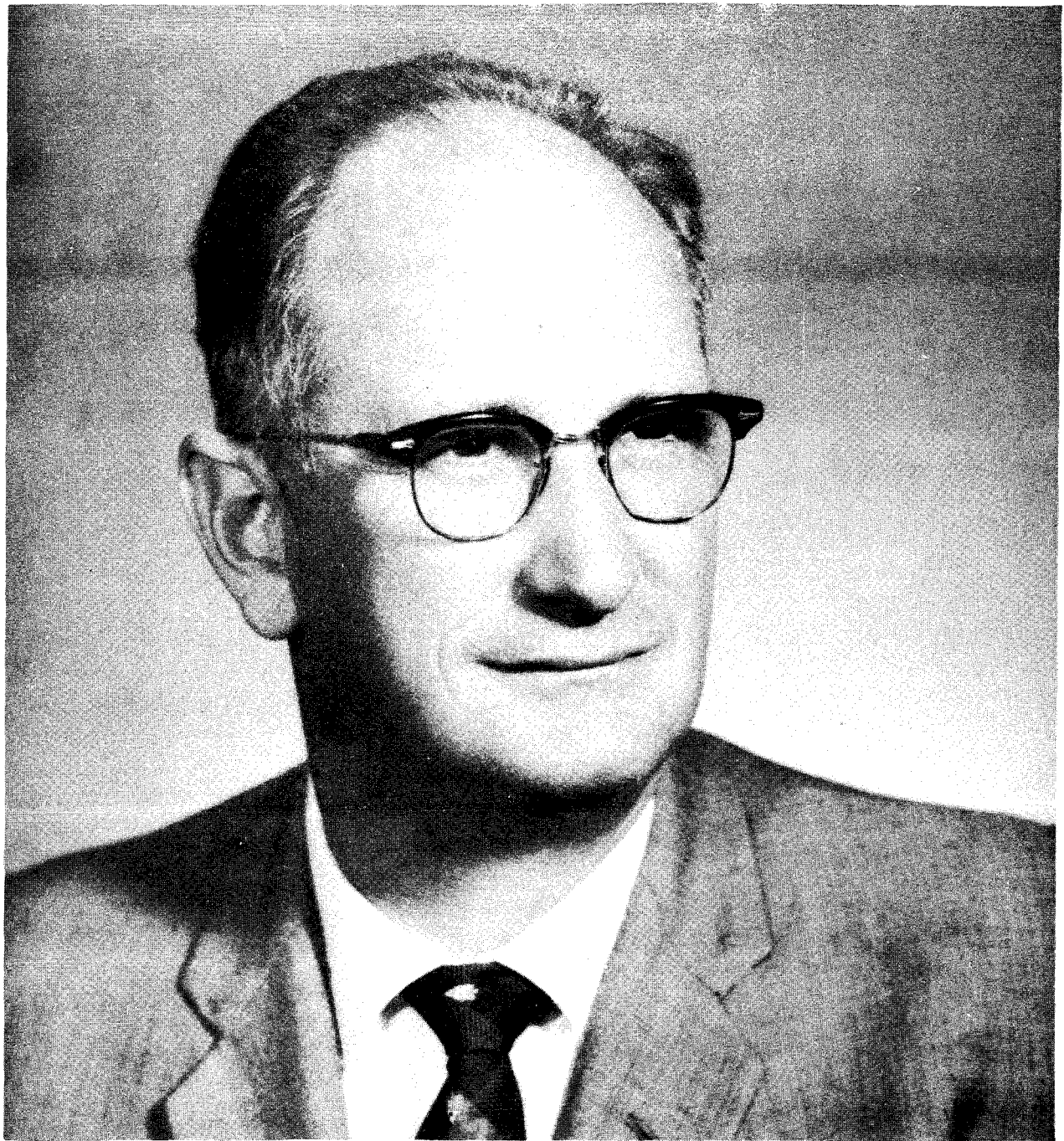

The California Interscholastic Federation hereby dedicates the 1961 North Coast Section Division II, Track and Field Meet, to Laurance J. Hill, District Superintendent of the Campbell Union High School District.

Mr. Hill has served the District fifteen years as Principal of Campbell High School and District Superintendent of a rapidly growing area which will have four large high schools open in the fall of 1961.

During the years of his administration, the high school student population has increased more than tenfold, yet the schools have never been on double session, the educational program has continued to develop in a very fine manner, and excellent facilities have been provided for the youth of the district. School facilities include well-lighted attractive classrooms, excellent athletic equipment, and fine facilities for teaching all high school subjects. Every effort is made to secure the finest type teacher for every classroom.

In addition to Mr. Hill's duties as District Superintendent of the Campbell Union High School District, he has had a great interest in young people and the sports programs which are indicated by these achievements.

He introduced Little League to the Campbell area and served as President for several years;

He has held practically every office in the Boy Scout program, including the presidency of the Santa Clara County Council for three years and is now serving as the Council's representative to the National Council;

He organized the Recreation Program in the Campbell Union High School District, including the summer swimming program, teen centers, playgrounds, etc. He has served as President of this program from its beginning over ten years ago to the present time.

His record in community and service organizations include past President of the Campbell Chamber of Commerce, San Jose Knights of the Round Table, Campbell Kiwanis, Campbell Red Cross, Section 6A Superintendents' Association, Santa Clara County Secondary School Superintendents' Association, and others.

The teenagers in the community and the coaches of California are deeply appreciative of the wonderful influence which Mr. Hill has been in our community. We pay tribute at this time to the dedicated service of Laurance J. Hill and we extend to him our heartiest thanks.

Unless the unexpected happens, today's gathering on the Camden High School oval should be called a Field AND Track meet instead of the usually accepted term of Track & Field meet.

The sport is known for unexpected happenings, but it will take unusually good performances for the runners to outdo one of the finest fields of weightmen ever gathered for one high school meet.

On display today will be a boy with the best shot put mark ever by a California prep and another with the best discus toss by a Golden Stater. They are Cubberley's Don Castle (64-3) in shot put and Los Altos' Bob Stoecker (181 ft.) in discus. Stoecker's toss is also the best ever by a high school junior.

The amazing Castle, comparatively small at 6 ft. and 185 lbs., should have little difficulty winning the shot, but Stoecker is no cinch in the platter throwing event.

A torrid duel for team honors shapes up between Cubberley and Carlmont, SPAL rivals, with defending champion Menlo-Atherton, also of the same circuit, having a good chance to repeat. The team with the best chance from outside the SPAL appears to be Los Altos, four-time winner of the West-SCVAL crown.

Competition for the first places is always heated, but just as important will be the battles for seconds, thirds, and fourths. Reasons for that, of course, is that the first four in each event will have a chance to compete next week in the North Coast Section finals at Berkeley with the first three there earning a trip to Los Angeles June 3 for the California Interscholastic Federation championships.

TRACK EVENTS--

100--Jim Cheatham of Menlo-Atherton rates favoritism off 9.7 best with SPAL rivals Fred Benjamin (9.8) and Bruce Asch of Cubberley and Capuchino's Ted Mitchell (10.0 & 9.7w) given best chance for upset. Cupertino's Clem O'Neal (9.8) and Buchser's Ron Gardner (9.9) longshots.

220--Cheatham stronger here than in 100 with his 21.1 earning him spot among national leaders. Chief threats same as in 100 with Cupertino's Jim Duran also a factor after victory in West--SCVAL finals. Russ Pierce of Washington (Fremont) could surprise and Ted Mitchell has windy 21.7.

440--Rematch of King City Invitational between Manuel Donato of Live Oak (49.4n) and sophomore Jim Duran of Cupertino (49.6n) spices one lapper. Add Coast Counties champ Al Smith of North Salinas, Andrew Hill's Ray Medina (50.5) and SPAL winner Hardy Watkins also figure. Duran's clocking one of best in nation by a 10th grader.

880--Dave Fishback of San Mateo (1:56.9) boasts fastest clocking going into Divisional meet but may have to better his best to hold off good field. Jim Smith of Ravenswood (1:58.0) capable of winning it all, and so are Hillsdale's Bob Crawford, Doug Pennington or Steve Plake of Buchser, Doug Ayers of Santa Clara, Taylor Clayton of Los Gatos, or Jack Parsons of Washington (Fremont)

Mile--Looms as best event on track. Dave Kamrar of Carlmont (4:20.5) and Dick Singleton of Hillsdale (4:21.9) are pre-meet favorites with unpressed Bert Stringer of Santa Clara (4:24.9) getting heavy backing from West--SCVAL supporters. Peninsula loop champ Anibal Davila (Jefferson of Daly City) (4:26.2) Dave Carter of Washington (Fremont) and Larry Winward (Hillsdale) all rate a good chance in a fast field.

120 H.H.--Gary Gaskill of Carlmont (14.3) should win but may experience trouble from West--SCVAL record breaker Bob Owen of Los Altos (14.6) who hopes to repeat early season victory over the SPAL champ and second place finisher in the West Coast Relays. Phil Arnaudo of Mountain View is a threat and Carlmont has second strong entry in Bob Sawyer (14.7).

180 L.H.--Gaskill appears to be class of field off 18.9 best which some say was aided by wind. Wind or not, Scot standout is a tough competitor and should win. Sawyer (19.7) will be trying to make it a one-two finish for Scots and Guy Newgren of Lincoln (19.8) will be trying just as hard to prevent such an occurrence. Bill Johnson of Salinas (19.7) could be a factor and so could Arnaudo, Owen and Bob Baughman of Campbell, along with San Mateo's George Smith (20.6 on 195 yard course.)

880 Relay--SPAL trio of Carlmont (1:29.8), Cubberley (1:30.1) and Menlo-Atherton (1:30.4) will be challenged by Cupertino (1:30.5), impressive West-SCVAL champs. This event could decide the meet.

Shot Put--Probably greatest field ever brought together for a Northern California meet, and not only because of presence of Cubberley's Don Castle whose 64-3 is best ever by a California prep and fourth best in prep history. One other boy has blasted out over 59 ft. and four others over 58. This is no place for 55-footers, and there are several others in that category including Spencer Profit (55- $\frac{1}{2}$) of host school Camden who is brother of meet record holder Mike Profit who competed at Campbell in mid-50's. Castle has hit at least 62-2 in his last seven meets. Don Schmidt of King City did 59- $\frac{1}{2}$ last week. In 58-0 category are Jim Pinson of Willow Glen (58-8 $\frac{3}{4}$), Larry Kennedy of Menlo-Atherton (58-4 $\frac{3}{4}$), and juniors Bob Stoecker (58-4 $\frac{3}{4}$) and Randy Schneider (58-3) of Los Altos.

Discus--Possibly the greatest field ever gathered for a high school meet. Event includes 1960 Scholastic Coach All-American Don Schmidt of King City (175- $\frac{1}{2}$) and Bob Stoecker of Los Altos (181 ft.), new national junior class record holder who has thrown past 190 ft. in workouts. National record is 194-5 and Stoecker's 181 is ninth best on the all-time high school list. Giving event additional class are Max Leetzow of Los Altos (173-0), Tyler Wilkins of Mountain View, a junior (172-8), Don Castle of Cubberley (170-7) and Larry Kennedy of Menlo-Atherton (163-3). Randy Schneider (171-6) third of Los Altos' great platter slinging trio, failed to qualify through the tough West-SCVAL meet.

High Jump--Unpredictable event. Jack Schraub of Campbell has season's best leap at 6-4 $\frac{3}{4}$ but finished only third in West-SCVAL meet. May regain form today, but any of a number could emerge the victor. Cubberley has a good boy in Bob Ballard (6-3 $\frac{3}{4}$), who was eliminated in SPAL meet by Charles Haddix of Sequoia at 6-2. Clayton Anderson of Fremont, with best of 6-3, won West-SCVAL crown and has been consistent last half of season.

Pole Vault--A real good duel looms here between SPAL rivals Stan Phillips of Carlmont (13-6) and Dan Washer of Cubberley (13-5). Jerry McDougall of Cubberley only other varsity performer over 13 ft. Only other vaulter over 13 ft. is Roger Werne of Los Gatos "B" team. Claude Schmidt of Santa Cruz is two-time Coast Counties champ (12-7 3/4) who could surprise.

Broad Jump--Many have been flirting with 23 ft. mark but only Jim Cheatham of Menlo-Atherton has actually achieved the distance and that was last year. Gary Gaskill's 22-10 3/4 is best mark in field, but Monterey has two good jumpers in Willie Wright and Mark Vance who could finish one-two.
