DATE AND PLACE

Saturday, June 3, 1961 at East Los Angeles College Stadium

TIME

Trial heats begin at 9:30 a.m. in the sprints, hurdles, and 880-yard relay. Finals will be held in the afternoon, with the discus at 11 a.m. and the pole vault at 1 p.m. Shot put, high jump, and broad jump will begin at 2 p.m. The first exhibition running event will be held at 2 p.m., the class C 440-yard relay, and the first regular running event, the 880, will be held at 2:30. ENTRIES

The number of entries for the State Meet allowed by section is as follows:

Southern, 4; Los Angeles, 3; North Coast, 3; Sacramento-San Joaquin, 2; Central, 2; San Francisco, 1; Oakland, 1; North, 1; San Diego, 1.

SCORING

Scoring in all events will be as follows:

5 points for 1st place
4 points for 2nd place
3 points for 3rd place
2 points for 4th place
1 point for 5th place

No points will be awarded placers in the special events

AWARDS

All five place winners in each event will be awarded medals, with duplicate medals awarded in case of ties.

PHOTO FINISHES

A finish line camera will be used as an aid in determining official order of finish in the heats and finals. Decisions of finish in the heats and finals by the judges will be subject to change after a review of the official movies.

PRESS ARRANGEMENTS

East Los Angeles College Stadium's track press facilities are located in the press box atop the south side of the stadium. This overlooks the finish of the 440, 880, Mile, and 880 and Mile relay events. 100, 220, high hurdles, and low hurdles will finish on the north side of the stadium.

FIELD PASSES

Except for photographers, no press personnel will be allowed on the field during the meet.
