Savage's 15½ Vault Not National Record

Marc Savage, just out of high school, is just out of a national scholastic record.

The former Claremont High athlete pole vaulted 15½ Saturday at the Golden West Invitational track meet at Los Angeles State College—good enough to break the national prep record of 15 feet.

But because Savage has been graduated from high school, the record won't be official. The mark, however, will be recognized as the best-ever prep performance.

Savage, 18, expects to enter the University of California in the fall. He was named "athlete of the meet" at Saturday's all-star spikefest.

Don Shy, who was a football and track standout at Ganesha High, finished second in the high hurdles Saturday. Shy was clocked in 14.1.
