vorite to take the first three places in the mile, Aragon is also counting on relay points that were not obvious in yesterday's trials. The Dons have posted the best time in the league for the event.

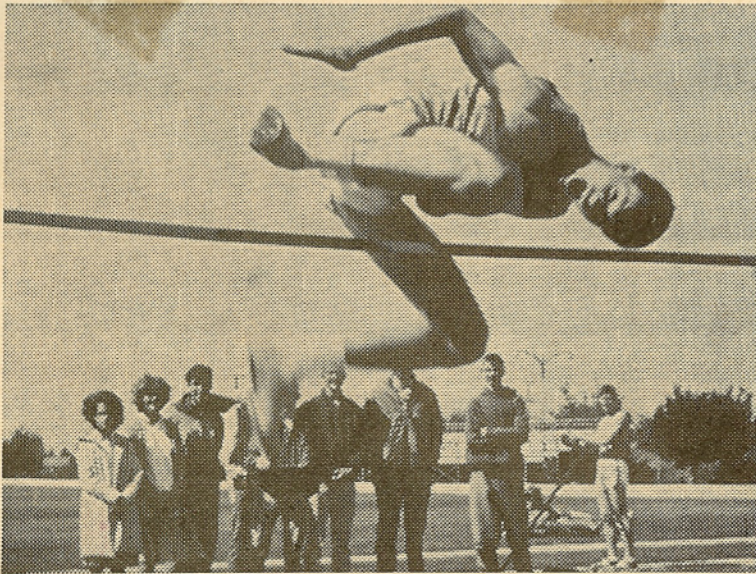
Capuchino, with 16 qualifiers, and San Mateo with 14, may fight it out for third place honors.
